

Romans 1:16-17

The Saving Power of God

- **I. Introduction:** Paul wrote this epistle to explain to the Roman church that mankind could be justified by God through faith in Jesus Christ by grace.
- II. The Saving Power of God (Rom 1:16-17).
 - A. Unashamed (v. 16).
 - 1. Paul said he was unashamed of the gospel because it was the power of God, even though it was outwardly offensive to lost sinners.
 - B. Power (v. 16).
 - 1. Paul wanted the Christians to know that the gospel powerfully converts people throughout the world despite their objections to it.
 - C. Salvation (v. 16).
 - 1. Paul says that the good news of the gospel is that God rescues sinners from eternal destruction in hell because He has the power to save.
 - D. Righteousness (v. 17).
 - 1. Paul said the righteousness of God has come down from heaven and reconciled us to Him, so that we can come to heaven and live with Him forever.
 - E. Faith (v. 17).
 - 1. Paul taught in Romans that sinners are credited with God's righteousness by faith in Jesus Christ, through His finished work on the cross.
- **III. Conclusion:** Paul wanted the Roman believers to know that the gospel is God's saving power in which His righteousness is applied to believers through faith in Christ.



Questions About: The Saving Power of God

- 1. What is the central theme of Romans? (Rom 1:16-17) How are sinners justified before God? (v. 17) How did this one passage become the spark for the Reformation? (v. 17)
- 2. Why was Paul unashamed to preach the gospel? (Rom 1:16) Why would Paul be tempted to feel ashamed to preach it? (1 Cor 1:18) Why was Timothy intimidated? (2 Tim 1:6-12)
- 3. How had Paul experienced the gospel's power? (1 Cor 1:18, 1 Thess 1:4) Why are sinners unable to save themselves? (Rom 5:6) What kind of power does God possess? (Ps 89:8)
- 4. Why are sinners in need of salvation? (Rom 1:16) How can Jesus set us free from sin's power? (John 8:34-36) How can we be set free from the penalty of sin? (Rom 5:9)
- 5. How has God provided the righteousness we need? (Rom 1:17) Where did this righteousness originate? (v. 17; Rom 3:22) Why do sinners need someone else's righteousness? (Isa 64:6)
- 6. How did Paul say he had an alien righteousness given to him? (Phil 3:8-9) How was Abraham credited with God's righteousness? (Rom 4:3) Why is this important for us?
- 7. How are sinners justified before God? (Rom 1:17) How is faith a gift from God? (Eph 2:8-9) Why is this good news? Why do man's efforts fall short of God's glory? (Rom 3:23)
- 8. How would you define the gospel message? (Rom 1:16-17) What would you say if someone asked you how they can be saved? (Mark 1:15) Why is understanding the gospel critical?

Prayer

- 1. Pray that God would help you understand the gospel message with greater clarity.
- 2. Ask God to help you proclaim the gospel unashamedly to those who are lost.
