

Mark 8:27-33

Confessing Jesus as Christ

- **I. Introduction:** Jesus led the disciples to Caesarea Philippi, where He asked them about His true identity, and Peter confessed that Jesus is God's Son and Messiah.
- II. Confessing Jesus as Christ (Mark 8:27-33).
 - A. Jesus' Probing Question (vv. 27-28).
 - 1. Jesus traveled to Caesarea Philippi with His disciples, where He questioned them about His identity to see if they correctly understood who He really is.
 - B. Peter's Great Confession (vv. 29-30).
 - 1. Peter boldly proclaimed that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and was commended by the Lord for his spiritual discernment.
 - C. Jesus' Severe Admonition (vv. 31-33).
 - 1. When Jesus revealed that He would suffer and die, Peter took Him aside and rebuked Him, but the Lord reprimanded Peter for his devilish response.
- **III. Conclusion:** Jesus explained to the disciples that He would eventually be killed and that anyone who stood in His way of going to the cross was His enemy.



Questions About: Confessing Jesus as Christ

- 1. What is the greatest confession the disciples ever made? Why is this passage the climax of Mark's gospel? Why does our confession matter? (**Rom 10:9-10; 1 John 2:22-24; 4:1-3**)
- 2. Where did Jesus lead the disciples after He healed the blind man? (Mark 8:27-33) For what was Caesarea Philippi known? What question did Jesus ask the disciples? (v. 27)
- 3. What did the people say about Jesus? (Mark 8:27-28) Why did they believe Jesus was John the Baptist? (Mark 6:15-16) Why Elijah? (Mal 4:5) Why Jeremiah? (Matt 16:14)
- 4. Why did Jesus ask them who they thought He was? (Mark 8:29-20) What did Peter say to Jesus? (v. 29) What does "Christ" mean? (v. 29) Why was this a monumental confession?
- 5. What commendation did Jesus give to Peter? (Matt 16:17-20) Who did Jesus say revealed this truth to Peter? (Matt 16:17) Why did Jesus warn them not to tell anyone? (Mark 8:30)
- 6. What did Jesus begin to tell them would happen to the Messiah? (Mark 8:31-33) Why did Jesus say that these things must happen? (v. 31) What did Jews believe about the Messiah?
- 7. What was Peter's reaction to Jesus' teaching? (Mark 8:31-33) Why did he react so strongly to Jesus' words? (v. 32) How did Jesus respond to Peter's rebuke? (Mark 8:31-33)
- 8. Why did Jesus refer to Peter as Satan? (Mark 8:31-33) How did Peter place man's interests before God's? (v. 33) Have you confessed Jesus as your Lord?

Prayers:

- 1. Ask God to help you to understand more clearly who Jesus is and what He came to do.
- 2. Pray that Jesus might help you to follow Him in joyful obedience.
