

## **Luke 2:21-40**

## The Post-Christmas Testimonies

- **I. Introduction:** Luke records for us the experiences of Mary and Joseph after the birth of Jesus, when He was dedicated to the Lord, and those who testified about Him.
- II. The Post-Christmas Testimonies (Luke 2:21-40).
  - A. The Presentation of Messiah (vv. 21-24).
    - 1. Joseph and Mary circumcised Jesus as good, observant Jewish parents, and then they took Him to the temple for dedication to the Lord.
  - B. The Prophecy of Salvation (vv. 25-32)
    - 1. Simeon was a faithful man who was waiting for the Messiah, and he had the privilege of dedicating Jesus and prophesying that He would bring salvation.
  - C. The Prediction of Separation (vv. 33-35).
    - 1. Simeon then predicts that Jesus would cause division in Israel, as some would believe in Him and others would be opposed to Him.
  - D. The Praise of Redemption (vv. 36-40)
    - 1. While Simeon was predicting Jesus' future, a widow named Anna came and began praising God for His plan of redemption.
- **III. Conclusion:** Those who heard of Jesus testified about Him to everyone they knew, telling them of His greatness and praising God for His work of salvation.



## **Questions About: The Post-Christmas Testimonies**

- 1. What happens when Christmas is over? What testimonies came after the Christmas story? (Luke 2:21-40) Why are these testimonies about Jesus important? (Deut 19:15)
- 2. What did Mary and Joseph do after Jesus was born? (Luke 2:21-24) Why did they bring Jesus to the temple? (vv. 22-24) Why did they need to present Jesus to the Lord? (v. 22)
- 3. How long were the days of Mary's purification? (Lev 12:2-5) What did their sacrifice tell us about Mary and Joseph? (Lev 12:1-8) What was their religious duty to God? (Ex 13:1-12)
- 4. Who was Simeon? (Luke 2:25-35) How did Simeon know that he would see the Messiah before he died? (v. 26) What did it mean that he had seen God's salvation? (v. 30)
- 5. Why did Simeon say he could die satisfied? (Luke 2:25-35) What did Simeon reveal about God's plan of redemption? (v. 32) Why would this have been surprising to the Jews?
- 6. What did Simeon predict about Jesus' reception? (Luke 2:33-35) How would Jesus lead to the falling and rising of many in Israel? (v. 34) How would a sword pierce Mary's soul? (v. 35)
- 7. Who was Anna? (Luke 2:36-38) Where did she live during her life? (v. 37) How did she minister before the Lord? (v. 37) How did she testify about Jesus' identity? (v. 38)
- 8. What are we to do after Christmas? (Matt 28:19-20) How are we to live in anticipation of Jesus like these saints? How will Jesus save humanity? (Ezek 36:24-28) Who should we tell?

## **Prayer**

- 1. Pray that God would help you to testify about what Jesus has done in your life.
- 2. Ask God to help you to live in anticipation of Jesus' return so you might better serve Him.
