Magic tricks and illusions have a way of sparking wonder and curiosity. But long before today's magicians, Daniel and his friends stood out during the Babylonian exile. They were wiser than the magicians and astrologers of their time because they looked to God for wisdom. Through their brave actions and wise choices, they showed God's power to everyone around them—no tricks needed! In this 4-week series, kids will learn that God helps us choose wisely, God is ready to rescue us, God's words show us what to do, and our courage can help others see God.

### **BIG IDEAS & BIBLE STORIES**

- 1. God helps us choose wisely. (Daniel's Training in Babylon: Daniel 1; 2 Timothy 1:7-14)
- 2. God is ready to rescue us. (Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego: Daniel 3; 2 Timothy 2:8-15)
- 3. God's words show us what to do. (The Writing on the Wall: Daniel 5; 2 Timothy 3:14-4:5)
- 4. Our courage can help others see God. (Daniel in the Lions' Den: Daniel 6; 2 Timothy 4:6-8, 16-18)

#### WEEKLY CURRICULUM SUMMARIES:

- I. This week, the story of Daniel's training in Babylon reveals how to choose God. Whether it's a card, a number, or a cup, some of the best illusions ask us to make difficult choices. This week, we'll hear about a difficult choice Daniel and his friends needed to make: to listen to God or follow a king's command. Their trust in God throughout this incredible story reminds us that when we face difficult decisions, God helps us choose wisely.
- 2. This week, the story of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego reveals how God rescued them from a fiery furnace.

  Some of the most memorable illusions amaze us with impossible escapes that we just can't understand. This week, we'll hear how God rescued Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego from a fiery furnace—and it wasn't an illusion. Their incredible story reminds us that when we need help facing the challenges in our lives, God is ready to rescue us.
- 3. This week, the story of Daniel interpreting the writing on the wall reveals how to follow God's words. Illusions are designed to be mysterious, and illusionists swear never to reveal their secrets. This week, we'll hear how Daniel used the wisdom God gave him to reveal the meaning behind some mysterious writing. By uncovering what no one else could, Daniel's story helps us see how God's words show us what to do and help guide us through every challenge we face.
- 4. This week, the story of Daniel in the lions' den reveals how to stand up for God. Every illusion takes courage, whether trusting an assistant with a saw or performing in front of a crowd. This week, we'll hear about the time Daniel showed courage by praying to God, even though he knew it would put him in danger. His bravery revealed God's power to the whole kingdom and helps remind us that our courage can help others see God.
