


'OUR REFUGE'

"The Lord is good, a refuge in times of trouble. He cares for those who trust in him,"
Nahum 1:7 NIV

"God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble. Therefore we will not fear, though the earth give way and the mountains fall into the heart of the sea, though its waters roar and foam and the mountains quake with their surging."
Psalms 46:1-3 NIV

Our world is in an uproar. There is hatred and fear, chaos and corruption, violence and injustice, division and pain. And it feels like it keeps getting worse. It's so easy to get overwhelmed and convince ourselves that "it's worse now than it's ever been." And maybe it is, or maybe it isn't. Either way, we still have the challenge of living in this moment. A recent devotion shared with me had the following quote:

"In the midst of chaos, we can be quick to forget how faithful God is."

Take a moment to reread that quote and reflect on it.

We know God is big. We know God is love. We know God is always faithful. But I'm afraid our language and our actions "betray" us. When we get consumed with "how bad the world is" we lose sight of God's goodness. We forget that God is there as a shelter in the time of storm.

The two passages at the top are important daily reminders for us.

Nahum tells us that God is GOOD, God is our refuge IN the time of trouble and God CARES. Those are powerful truths for us to remember. Our job is to trust God.

If things truly are worse than they've ever been, Psalm 46 is the perfect passage for us. The psalmist implores us to live beyond all consuming fear EVEN WHEN the world is falling apart BECAUSE God is our refuge.

If life seems off kilter right now, that's understandable. If problems seem too big for you right now, that's ok. But we need to constantly remind ourselves that God is ALWAYS BIGGER than our troubles.

God is our refuge, now and always.
