

This Fall we will be focusing on 1 John during our Sunday morning worship as we embark on our sermon series: "Light, Life, & Love." This short book has been incredibly influential in helping Christians navigate the questions of life while maintaining faith in the midst of struggles.

I felt drawn to this series for two main reasons.

- 1. We need to receive Light, Life, & Love in our lives. These three concepts are essential to our existence but oftentimes we find a void of these in the world around us. We need to be reminded that God's Light, Life, & Love are abundant. As we walk through this powerful book of the Bible, I invite us to hear with fresh ears the encouragement that these pages bring to us. Perhaps we can find for ourselves the overwhelming reality that "the one who is in you is greater than the one who is in the world." 1 John 4:4b
- 2. We need to reflect God's Light, Life, & Love with our lives. The Christian life is so much more than just receiving things from God. We are called to put the blessings of God into action and serve the world around us. Or as 1 John puts it, "But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, purifies us from all sin." 1 John 1:7

As we go through this sermon series I invite you to look for these things in your life. Listen to what God wants you to receive. And then, push yourself to reflect these things with your words and actions with your family, friends, co-workers, and everyone you meet.




