Dear Friend,

You get it. And I'm so thankful.

One precious child, one sweet life, one at a time.

With more than 600,000 reported cases of child abuse each year — and nearly 343,000 children in foster care nationwide (according to 2023 statistics) — it can be overwhelming to think there is any way to make a meaningful difference.

But you get it — and so do we. And, together, by God's love and grace, we've made far more than a small dent, we've reached 164,644 — one child at a time ... with lasting hope, memories that heal and bring joy, the promise of a future of worth and purpose ... and so much more.

One child, like Kimmy.

I can barely recount her story without tears. She came to camp, and she was *angelic*. What we didn't know at first was that Kimmy's overly compliant attitude was a defense mechanism — a concrete wall forged by years of abuse ... and neglect ... and loss ... and pain.

She was pulled from a difficult, unstable biological home. Lost her older brother in a car accident. Her middle brother was institutionalized — and she and her remaining brother were placed in a home where she was secretly being abused ...

But she would not report the abuse — because she knew they'd take her away from her only sibling. Fake smiles, obedience and "put on" happiness ... these were the only way she knew to hang on to any sense of security, family, and love.

This is when we first met Kimmy at camp. Smiling through horrific abuse. Defenses up.

For the first time ever, Kimmy experienced what it means to be *truly* loved for one whole week. She was treasured and valued. She was fed well ... and respected ... and honored. She ran, played, and laughed. She loved "Dress Up" time most of all — it was fun to dress up like a princess!

Kimmy's life was *radically* changed ... from the heart out.

She came back every summer she could until she was 12 years old ... then, at 16, she returned to serve as a volunteer.

Kimmy says her only happy childhood memories happened at Royal Family KIDS Camp.

She became part of the host church, where she met her husband-to-be. They married in

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2018 and started a family. Two years later, Kimmy became the first former camper to serve as a Chapter Director.

And, of course, she brought her wedding dress to "Dress Up," so other girls could feel like princesses, too. She wants campers to know there is joy, hope, and beauty at camp—dreams can come true!

This is your impact —

One life at a time, radically changed ... filled with hope and love; showered with grace, and worth, and purpose; a child, like Kimmy, set free from the excessive and damaging burdens of her past, empowered to move forward towards a better, brighter future.

And every day I thank God that you support this life-changing work, through your prayers and your generosity. Thank you for the beautiful, healing role you play in the lives of so many children like Kimmy!

Through our Royal Family KIDS Camp and Mentoring programs, you are helping to <u>address the problem</u> of relational trauma and equip local churches to step up with love and hope for children like Kimmy.


