We have already been leading trainings at conferences and churches AND have been invited to countries like Poland (to help organizations working with Ukrainian refugees) and Ethiopia working intensively with graduate students, to give them better understanding and tools to help them as they work with children in crisis. Our work will be to bring healing and hope to children and caregivers in crisis situations, through training, tools and resources, using **TBRI** and **Crisis Care Training**.
