## **Seven last plagues: Revelation 16**

After the John recalls the scene of the angels receiving the judgements and hearing the song of those who survived, he now proceeds to describe the seven bowls of God’s wrath being poured out on the earth. Unlike the previous judgements all of these are universal and more intense.

*First bowl: Revelation 16:2*
