Confession of Faith: The acknowledgement of and commitment to God. Simply put it is the declaration and commitment to God or particularly to Jesus Christ.
Confess: Greek word <i>homologeo:</i> together, speak to a conclusion, to speak the same to agree, to profess, to align with or endorse, declare and admit.
Who should we come together and agree with? Why?
Cross Reference: Isaiah 1:18-19 Confession and Profession in the Old Testament:
In the Old Testament, the people of God would take 3 scriptures and recite them twice daily. This declaration of faith called the Shema. Even today many Jews continue this practice. Here are the following terms and scriptures:
Shema: Hebrew word to listen, hear, call gather together, carefully, certainly, consent, consider.
