In King Solomon's day they didn't have email, text, or telephone. Therefore, one of the best ways to communicate was to hire someone to deliver a message. However not all assigned messengers were equally reliable.			
Fool: Stupid, silly, one who lacks wisdom and rejects the fear of the Lord.

Honor: Hebrew word kavod; meaning properly, weight, heaviness, glory, reputation; describing what is weighty in a moral, social, or spiritual sense, human dignity. The visible manifestation of divine presence.
