The Long-Range Planning Committee (LRP) will re-form the “Family Life Center Planning Committee” (FLCPC) that was established on June 19, 2011, to advance the project’s vision and plan.

The FLCPC will be composed of representatives from the following church committees/groups/teams: Benevolence, Building & Grounds, Children & Youth, Discipleship, Finance, Personnel, Security, Social, Sunday School, and Technology.

Additionally, representatives from the LRP and Deacons are being appointed. All appointed representatives are expected to commit to a five-year term to ensure project continuity.

Committee Quarterly Reports
Quarter: Fourth Quarter 2025 (October–December)

Baptismal Committee

During this quarter, one baptism service was held on Sunday, October 26, 2025. Four individuals—Caylee Loadholt, Ashlyn Kindsey, Kaden Edgeman, and Braley Shuler — were baptized by Donnie Groff. The baptism pool functioned properly on the day of the service. The Baptism Committee also completed painting of the baptism pool during the quarter. During this process, it was noted that the pool was retaining some water. Following the completion of the painting, the committee expressed interest in purchasing a baptism chair/bench to better support both baptism candidates and those administering the baptisms. The Baptism Committee maintains a standing schedule of one baptism service per quarter unless an alternate date is requested. Baptisms are scheduled for the second Sunday of the third month of each quarter. The next scheduled baptism will be held on March 8, 2026.

Benevolence Committee

Four requests were received but did not meet the established requirements. One anonymous church member received \$100.00 in assistance for utility expenses. All required documentation was provided, and the request was approved as this individual had not made a prior request during the current chairman’s term. The Benevolence Fund is maintained as a line item within the Mission Fund Account. If additional benevolence requests are approved, the Benevolence Team will notify the Deacons accordingly.

Brotherhood

The Bamberg First Baptist Church Brotherhood hosted a Brotherhood Supper in the fellowship hall. Brother Paul Mitchell delivered the message and attendance totaled 32. The Bamberg–Barnwell Brotherhood Associational Meeting was at Seven Pines Baptist Church. Twelve brothers from Bamberg First Baptist Church were in attendance.

Budget and Finance Committee

The Budget and Finance Committee met three times during the quarter. Topics discussed included:

1. Electronic Signatures and Accountability

A new accountability process will be implemented to accommodate increased use of automatic drafts. The church treasurer will prepare a weekly transaction register listing all checks and electronic drafts, which will be reviewed and signed by the Budget and Finance Chair. This protocol will be incorporated into the 2026 Budget & Finance Implementation Plan.

2. Training Initiatives

New financial procedures are being developed, including: Submission of timesheets for certain work, Mileage reimbursement in place of gas receipts and Compensation planning Training for these initiatives will begin in Q1 2026.

3. External Audit

An external audit is currently underway, conducted by McGregor & Company, LLP of Barnwell. All requested documentation has been provided, with plans to complete the audit by January 15, 2026.

4. 2026 Budget Approval – The 2026 budget approval process was completed during the quarter. The committee expressed appreciation to all individuals who contributed to its development.

Buildings and Grounds

During the past quarter, the Building and Grounds Committee began reviewing church power usage to identify potential reductions in monthly utility costs. The Robert Black Fellowship Classroom, located below the sanctuary, was painted. The existing lights in this room are scheduled to be replaced with LED lighting in January. The baptistry area was painted. One sanctuary HVAC unit was repaired. The outside condenser and compressor were replaced. Members are asked to report maintenance needs as they are identified.

Children & Youth Ministry

Children’s Ministry activities included Wednesday night programming (6:00–7:30 p.m.), Sunday School, Children’s Church, nursery care, and Christmas caroling to shut-ins. Two volunteer meetings were held in October, focusing on commitments and background checks. Youth Ministry activities included Wednesday night and Sunday night services, Sunday School, FCA meetings on Wednesday and Friday mornings, and participation in flock sermons and renewal nights.

Discipleship

The Discipleship Team reviewed and discussed the church’s Purpose Statement, clarifying key language and refining team goals and objectives. The team approved support for the launch of Celebrate Recovery, with the first twelve-step study group beginning January 8, 2026. Leaders will be identified from this group to facilitate future studies, with plans to open the program to the community in Fall 2026. Additionally, the team is developing a list of Points of Contact (POCs) to serve alongside other ministry teams, ensuring discipleship remains central to all ministries at FBC. A representative was also selected to serve on the Family Life Center Subgroup.

Hospitality Team

Seventeen visitors were recognized during the quarter. Team members and church staff followed up with visitors to thank them for attending, address questions, and receive prayer requests. Total visitors for the year reached thirty. Visitor information was shared with Sunday School leadership and the Discipleship Team for continued engagement. Several visitors from previous quarters are now designated as Regular Attendees and have been assigned deacons. Others have expressed interest in church membership and plan to meet with the pastor. First Quarter 2026 Serving Teams: **January:** Jessi Black, Kim & Tommy Trantham; **February:** Faren Stroman, Jamie Brabham; **March:** Ashley Zeigler, Paul & Julie Mtchell.

New leadership for 2026 includes Jamie Brabham (Chair), Stephanie Hutto (Vice Chair), and Renee Jeffcoat (Recorder). Membership records continue to be maintained in SubSplash, with updates planned for early 2026.

Social Committee

Sunday School Committee

The average attendance for Sunday School was: October – 98, November – 102 and December – 106. The Sunday School Committee hosted a lunch for teachers and their families. 2026 leadership, teacher training, and promotion dates have been set.

Technology Team

During the quarter, the Technology Team focused on improving system security and enhancing meeting-room technology. Installed Norton antivirus protection on all Windows-based computers to improve security and protect church systems from malware and viruses. Installed an Apple TV in the conference room to support wireless screen sharing and improve presentations during meetings and training. Projects and initiatives have been outlined for 2026.

Transportation Committee

Both vans were detailed. New tires were installed on the cargo trailer, and a new spare tire was purchased.

Ushering Committee

Ushers assisted with the distribution and collection of ballots, worship materials, and offerings, provided greeting services, and distributed candles for the Candlelight Service.

Wheelchair Ramp Task Team

The team met three times and completed construction of two wheelchair ramps – one from new materials and one from a metal ramp. One ramp was disassembled at the Deloris Bunch residence. Storage improvements and trailer repairs are planned for 2026. Currently active ramps include: Bamberg: 28, Ehrhardt: 2, Denmark: 1, Cope: 1 and Branchville: 1

WMU

WMU established two new mission groups and completed two major mission projects: Delivery of 40 backpacks to Appalachia / Delivery of 25 prisoner bags to state prisons. Leader training was also conducted during the quarter.

Women at the Well Ministry

Activities included leadership meetings, event evaluations, attendance at the Brandon Lake concert, continued Secret Vessels prayer initiative, and a year-end luncheon.
