#### A Life Worthy of the Gospel

There have been moments in my life where I have strived to make a dream come true. For most of my childhood, I wanted to grow up to be a MLB player. I remember being at my grandma's house; she had big mirror sliding closet doors in her bedroom. I would stand in front of those mirrors watching a baseball game on the TV, and every time the pitcher would throw the pitch, I would swing. The imagination that a kid holds, the hope of one day becoming what he has always imagined, is priceless.

Then I got into 4<sup>th</sup> grade and began to play basketball, and my attention and passion turned from baseball to basketball. I remember the first time I laid my hands on that ball: I fell in love with the game. Day and night, you would find me playing and trying to perfect that craft in pursuit of my new dream of becoming an NBA player. I mirrored Kobe Bryant's game, I mirrored his shot, I mirrored his fade away jumper. I wanted to be like Kobe Bryant.

In our spiritual journeys, we are called to mirror the life of one person, THE person: our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. Paul writes a letter to the church in Philippi and includes a verse that always has brought conviction to my life: *Whatever happens, conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ...* (Philippians 1:27 NIV) So I sit back and ask myself: do I live a life worthy of the Gospel? Paul doesn't just say, "When life is good, live a life worthy of the Gospel." Instead, he says, *whatever happens*. In the good and in the bad, we are all called to live this sort of life.

In many ways, God has gifted us His Word for this very purpose. We get to see great examples of what a life worthy of the Gospel looks like but also examples of what one doesn't look like. I have found myself devoting so much time to perfect a craft that, at the end, doesn't matter. The time I spent, the people I mirrored—at the end of it, it doesn't matter. I want to leave you with a set of questions to ask yourself: Who and what are you mirroring today? Is the life you are living today, a life worthy of the Gospel? Whatever happens, whatever comes our way, may our lives be a mirror of a life worthy of the Gospel.
