The Invitation

We get many invitations in our lives. We get invitations to parties, to weddings, to dinners, to concerts, and to Broadway shows.

As we read the New Testament, we see many times when Jesus extends an invitation. We see Jesus calling to the men he wanted to be his disciples. "Come ", he says, "Follow me and I will make you fishers of men." He entreats people to come to him. He asks all who are weary and carrying heavy burdens to come and he will give them rest.

He especially invites us to humble ourselves as we seek to share his love with others. In Luke 14:7-14, we read where He noticed how guests sometimes chose the places of honor at a dinner. He told a parable,

"When you are invited by someone to a wedding banquet, do not sit down at the place of honor, in case someone more distinguished than you has been invited by your host and the host may come saying, 'Give up your place,' and then in disgrace, you would take the lowest place.

Instead when you are invited, go sit in the lowest place, so that when the host comes, he may say to you, 'Friend, move higher', then you will be honored in the presence of all who sit at the table with the host. For those who exalt themselves will be humbled and those who humble themselves will be exalted.

Jesus extends a personal invitation to us. In Revelation 3:20 we read, "Listen! I am standing at the door, knocking; if you hear my voice and open the door, I will come in to you and eat with you and you with me."

Do you hear the invitation to come closer, the invitation to serve others, the invitation to make fishers of men, the invitation to give of yourself? If you do then open the door and invite Jesus in.


The Book of Matthew


