Serenity Prayer...Now More Than Ever!

The closing prayer at Highland Park's Celebrate Recovery meetings was always the Serenity Prayer:

"God grant me the serenity to accept the things I cannot change; the courage to change the things I can; and the wisdom to know the difference. Living one day at a time; enjoying one moment at a time; accepting hardships as the pathway to peace. Taking, as Jesus did, this sinful world as it is, not as I would have it; trusting that He will make all things right if I surrender to His will; that I may be reasonably happy in this life and supremely happy with Him forever in the next. Amen."

Our world is in desperate need of the serenity and peace that only Christ can provide. Our prayer lists are crowded with issues of loss of loved ones, of health crises, family dysfunctions, and financial needs of all types. The news feeds are filled with stories of homicides, wars, deportation fears, and unchecked anger, rage, and malice.

It was into this tumultuous world that Christ birthed His Church. It was to be a Church empowered by the Holy Spirit who alone can bring love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control (Galatians 5:22-23). That which Jesus declared would be blessed is the opposite of what the world sees as power and success. Jesus said that His blessings would be upon those who are poor in spirit, those who mourn, the meek, those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, the merciful, the pure in heart, the peacemakers, and those who are persecuted because of righteousness (Matthew 5:3-10). Perhaps our lack of serenity is due to the absence of what Jesus designed to bring us peace. There is a reason that Jesus pronounced blessing upon peacemakers! Will you renew your commitment to peacemaking so that, "the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus?" (Philippians 4:7).
