Vacation Bible School June 10-14 6:00-8:30pm

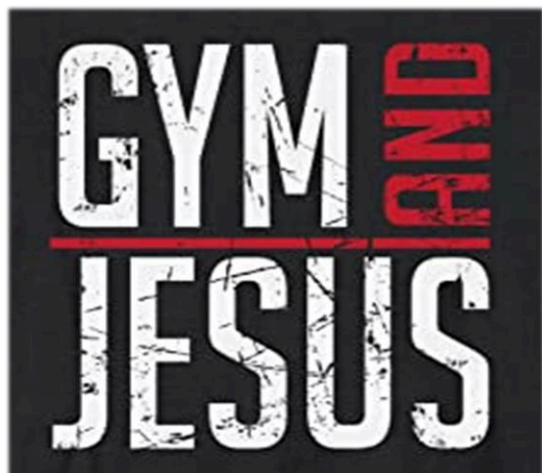

PASTOR SEARCH COMMITTEE NOMINATION PROCEDURE

Nomination forms will be available **Sunday March 24 and Sunday March 31, 2024**. They will be located in the vestibule, on the front pew and in the church office.

- * Prior to being nominated, nominees should clearly express willingness to serve on the Pastor Search Committee if elected. **It is the responsibility of those who offer the nominations to personally confirm that their nominee is indeed willing to serve if elected.**
- * Members may nominate more than one person.
- * Nominees must be members of Alexis Baptist Church.
- * Members may not nominate themselves.
- * Full-time staff members are not eligible for nomination.
- * Nominees must be at least 18 years of age.
- * It is permissible to nominate members of the same family but it must be understood that the Pastor Search Committee cannot have:
 - Husband – Wife members
 - Parent – Child members
 - Sibling Members

If two such family members are eventually elected to serve,
the one receiving the most votes will remain on the
committee whereas the other will be disqualified.

- * Forms may be placed in the white boxes in the vestibule, on the front pew, or returned to the church office.

NOMINATION FORMS ARE DUE BY:

****MONDAY APRIL 8, 2024 BY 12 PM****

**Any forms received after this due date and time,
WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

- * The names of all nominees will be compiled on a list in alphabetical order, announced and published to the church membership on **APRIL 14, 2024**. Once the nominee list is announced and published, the church membership will have at least one week to prayerfully consider who should serve. This list is **NOT** a ballot.
- * The vote will then take place during a business meeting after the **SUNDAY MORNING SERVICE ON APRIL 21, 2024** to determine the 5 members of the Pastor Search Committee.
 - Each church member may vote for as many as 5 candidates. **If you vote for MORE than 5, your vote will be disqualified.**
 - Only **ONE** ballot per church member.

- The nominee with the 6th highest number of votes will be the “alternate” on the Pastor Search Committee.
- In the event of a tie between #5 and #6, the surname, the first letter in the last name, in alphabetical order would be elected as alternate; in the event of matching surnames, the first names would be used in the same manner to determine the alternate.

* The Nominating Committee will tally the votes and the results will be announced **SUNDAY APRIL 28, 2024**, and published in the next newsletter.

There will be a special prayer of commission for the newly elected Pastor Search Committee that Sunday prior to their first meeting.
