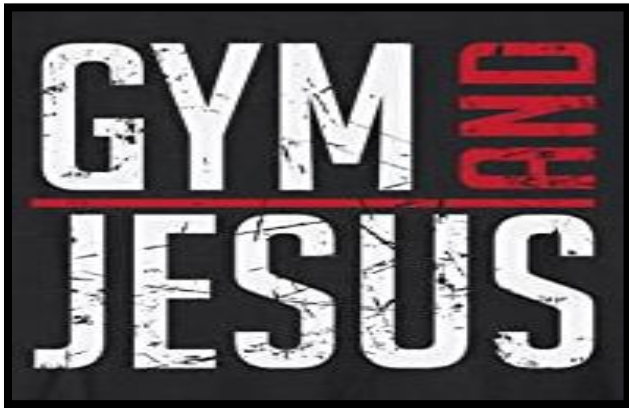
Robin Johnson Hospice House, Dallas, NC
