










## ACORNS SUMMER 2025

<b>Ascension Sunday</b> 6/1	<b>Jesus says Goodbye</b>		Jesus says goodbye to His friends but promises to be with them always.
<b>Pentecost Sunday</b> 6/8	<b>The Holy Spirit says Hello</b>		The Holy Spirit says hello, bringing power to the church to tell everyone, everywhere the Good News.
<b>Trinity Sunday</b> 6/15	<b>A Lesson on the Trinity</b>		The Holy Spirit is the third person of the Trinity. He lives in those who have faith as their helper, guide, and teacher.
<b>New Unit!</b> 6/22	<b>The Early Church</b>		Peter proclaims the Good News. People repent and are baptized. The Early Church is formed, gathering daily for the apostles teaching, breaking bread, and prayer.
6/29	<b>We are the Church Today</b>		We are part of God's One Big Story through our participation in his Church. We wait for Jesus to return and bring us home to heaven.
7/6	<b>The Promise of Heaven</b>		God's one big story ends with the future hope of heaven, where we will live forever with him.
7/13	<b>My Church Family</b>		The Church is not a building, but God's people gathered to worship by singing, listening to God's Word, receiving communion, and praying.

7/20	<b>Listening to God's Word</b>		When we gather together as God's family, we place ourselves under the authority of scripture, hear God speaking to us, and seek to respond to his voice.
7/27	<b>Communion</b>		Communion is the special meal we share as a church family to remember all that Jesus did. As we eat and drink by faith, we are assured of God's love, receive his grace, and declare we are part of God's family.
8/3	<b>Prayer</b>		When we gather together as God's family, we worship God and bring Him glory by praying together.
8/10	<b>Fellowship</b>		Jesus commands the church to love one another as he has loved us.
8/17	<b>Service and Proclamation</b>		Jesus has given the Church the same task as he gave his disciples – to go into the world, serve God and neighbor, and proclaim the gospel.
