

DAY 2 — MEETING GOD IN HIS PRESENCE

Exodus 33:14 (NKJV) “My Presence will go with you, and I will give you rest.”

DEVOTIONAL

God’s presence is not reserved for special moments or spiritual elites—it is promised to those who seek Him. Moses did not ask for better direction or provision; he asked for God’s presence. True transformation happens when we stop rushing past God and choose to linger.

Encounters often happen in stillness. Elijah heard God not in the wind, earthquake, or fire—but in a still, small voice. In fasting and praying, we slow our pace and quiet our souls to recognize Him.

God desires not just visitation, but habitation. He wants His presence to shape our thoughts, decisions, and desires. Today is about **abiding**, not striving.

REFLECTION QUESTIONS

- Do I make time to linger in God’s presence, or do I rush through prayer?
- What does God’s presence mean to me personally?
- Am I willing to be still long enough to hear His voice?

PRAYER FOCUS

- Invite the manifest presence of God into your life and church.
- Ask God to increase awareness of His nearness.
- Pray for spiritual rest and renewed strength.
- Ask God to speak clearly and personally.

PRAYER POINT DECLARATION: “Lord, your presence is what I desire more than anything else. Teach me to dwell, to listen, and to rest in You.”

FASTING FOCUS: Fast from distractions (media, social platforms, unnecessary noise). Use that time to sit quietly before God.
