

DAY 3 — TRANSFORMED BY THE ENCOUNTER

Exodus 34:29 (NKJV) “Now it was so, when Moses came down from Mount Sinai... that Moses did not know that the skin of his face shone while he talked with Him.”

DEVOTIONAL

A true encounter with God never leaves us unchanged. When Isaiah encountered God, he was cleansed and commissioned. When Saul encountered Jesus, he became Paul. God’s presence transforms identity, renews purpose, and ignites calling.

Encounters are not emotional moments to be remembered; they are spiritual markers that change how we live. God reveals Himself so that we may reflect Him to others. What He does *in us* is meant to flow *through us*.

Today, we pray not just for an encounter, but for **lasting fruit**—that what God begins in these days will shape our future.

REFLECTION QUESTIONS

- How has God been speaking to me during this fast?
- What changes is He calling me to make?
- How can I carry this encounter into daily life?

PRAYER FOCUS

- Thank God for what He has revealed and done.
- Ask for boldness to walk out transformation.
- Pray for renewed purpose and obedience.
- Ask God to use your life as a reflection of His glory.

PRAYER POINT DECLARATION: “Lord, I thank You for encountering me. Let my life reflect Your glory. Empower me to walk in obedience and purpose.”

FASTING FOCUS: End the fast with thanksgiving and dedication. Commit to ongoing spiritual disciplines that sustain the encounter.

CLOSING PRAYER

Lord, thank You for meeting us in these days of prayer and fasting. Seal what You have done in our hearts. Let this encounter mark our lives and draw us into deeper intimacy with You. In Jesus’ name, Amen.
