## PASTOR APPRECIATION MONTH Pastor Rich Jones



Pastor Rich Jones was born in Oklahoma City but raised in Phoenix and Tucson, Arizona. He graduated from Sabino High School in Tucson and began college at the University of Arizona. Rich remains an avid UA fan. After a couple of years at the UA, he enlisted in the United States Marine Corps in the fall of 1989 and finished his enlistment in the fall of 1993. During his time in the military, Rich's parents relocated to Amarillo, Texas. Through their encouragement, he enrolled at West Texas A&M. While attending college and living in Amarillo, Texas, Rich became very involved at Saint Stephen Methodist Church where God reminded him that he was called to be a preacher. He first experienced the call to ministry during confirmation class at Christ Church UMC in Tucson, Arizona during eighth grade. He then tried to change God's mind about it. It didn't work. In January of 1995, God used a sermon at Saint Stephen to remind Rich of His plans for his life. Rich graduated from WTAMU in December 1997 and enrolled at Asbury Theological Seminary in Wilmore Kentucky the next fall.

Following seminary, Rich served as the pastor at First Methodist Church in Rotan. Texas, as an associate pastor at Saint Stephen in Amarillo, and as the lead pastor at Wolfforth Methodist Church outside of Lubbock. Before coming to Aldersgate Abilene, Rich was the Presiding Elder for the East District of the West Plains Conference of the Global Methodist Church. In each of these places of ministry, Rich has said it has been amazing to see God change lives and further His kingdom and he can't wait to see what God does next!

Rich married Kimberly, an Occupational Therapist, in 2004. They welcomed their first child, Elijah, in 2007. Elijah is a recent graduate of Frenship High School and has recently started classes at South Plains College. Their daughter, Meleah, came along in 2010, and is a freshman in high school. They are both active in band and the youth group.
