YOUR CHILD DECIDED TO FOLLOW JESUS... NOW WHAT?

First, take a moment to celebrate—this is the most important decision your child will ever make! Choosing to follow Jesus is a life-changing step, and we want to come alongside you as you help guide and encourage them on this journey.

Here's a simple way we explain salvation to kids, using the ABCs:

A - ADMIT

The Bible tells us that everyone has done wrong (Romans 3:23). Even from a young age, kids naturally do things they know they shouldn't—like taking toys or talking back. That's because we're all born with a desire to go our own way instead of God's. Helping your child recognize and admit their own wrong choices is the first step toward a relationship with Jesus. It's not about shame, but about understanding our need for a Savior.

B - BELIEVE

Here's the good news: even though we all do wrong, God loves us deeply (Romans 5:8). He loves your child no matter what—on their best and worst days. God showed His love by coming to Earth as Jesus and taking the punishment for our sin. You can help your child understand this by relating it to something they've experienced: "Imagine someone took your punishment so you could go outside and play even though you made a mistake—that's what Jesus did, but in a much bigger way."

C - CHOOSE

Following Jesus means choosing to give your whole life to Him. When your child says "yes" to Jesus, they're choosing to trust Him as their leader and guide. Encourage your child that they can always talk to Jesus, especially when life feels scary or confusing—He promises to always be with them (Matthew 28:20).
