Legacy Projects

Vineland Campus // Mobile Launch

Through the 2025 Legacy Offering, our church family gave generously to launch our mobile campus in Cumberland County. We held our first service at Lakeside Middle School on April 6 and continue to set up each week to see lives changed, new families welcomed, and to make an eternal difference in the communities we serve.

Salem County // Correctional Campus Launch

We launched our second correctional campus in Salem County on October 23. Across our Chester and Salem County campuses, over 100 inmates now participate in weekly services that include worship, small groups, and prayer—encouraging men and women in their value in Christ.

Vineland Campus // Building Completion

Our Vineland Campus families are excited to see how God will use this space as more people meet Jesus and find meaningful biblical community.

Cumberland County // Correctional Campus Launch

We will launch our third correctional campus in Cumberland County in 2026. While details are still being finalized, we're eager to serve inmates through weekly services, small groups, and post-release support, with hopes to also host more family reunification events across all our correctional campuses this year.
