Three Enemies

“Comfort, comfort ye my people, speak ye peace,” thus saith our God; “Comfort those who sit in darkness, mourning beneath their sorrow’s load. Speak ye to Jerusalem of the peace that waits for them; tell her that her sins I cover and her warfare now is over.” (LSB 347)

The Church Calendar revolves around two great feasts: Christmas and Easter. As we begin our Church Year again, we prepare for Christmas. Our God chooses to reconcile you to himself by becoming one of you. The great

mystery of the incarnation is that God becomes man. Your Savior takes on the very body and blood that you and I have. Why does he do this? He does this so that your great enemies would be defeated and you would live victorious with him. As we begin Advent, we ponder this great gift from our God. It is a gift of love. It is a gift that imparts joy and hope. We are not alone, but fighting victorious with Jesus. In our suffering and tribulations, in our joys and thanksgivings, we know the outcome. Our enemies are all destroyed. Who are these enemies? Martin Luther suggests three enemies in his Small Catechism: the Devil, the World, and our Sinful Nature. These three do not want us to hallow God’s name or let his kingdom come. They would lead us into unbelief, despair, and other great shame and vice. As we ponder the incarnation of our Lord and prepare for Christmas, prepare yourself against these enemies. Know the truth of the Word against the devil’s lies and deceit, guard yourself against the temptations to pleasure, lust, and gluttony as the World dangles its treasures and fancies before your eyes, and remind yourself of the promises of God that are true against the doubt and despair your sinful flesh prepares for you. Remind all your enemies that the battle is won and they are made a footstool for the Lord’s feet. Happy New Year! — **Pastor Cholak**

that we must announce the cancellation of this year’s highly anticipated Nativity event.

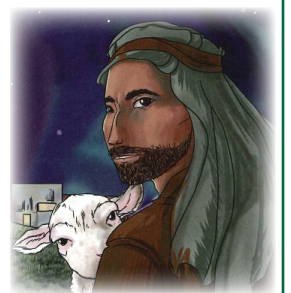

CHRISMONS

Look for Chrismons delivered to your child in Sunday School this month!

Several ladies from the congregation stitch the ornaments – each takes between 30 minutes to an hour – and then they are assembled and prepared for your child.

Chrismons are like little monograms for Christ, in that they give a brief picture of different names of Jesus or aspects of His Work for us. Each Chrismon ornament comes with a Bible verse reference on the back, as well as a brief explanation of the symbol of the ornament. This year, our Chrismon is a crown. Jesus Christ is King like no other – born humbly, to save us from our sin.

On his robe and on his thigh he has a name written, King of kings and Lord of lords. Revelation 19:16

We have a different design each year, on an 18-year cycle. If you would like your child to receive the Chrismons for years that he or she will not be in school, please contact Sarah in to the church office: sbaughman@osl.cc. If you've already ordered Chrismons, we are working on having frames made for those and will give them to you as soon as we can.

We offer these free of charge, but if you are so inclined, you may give a donation toward the OSL Nativity.

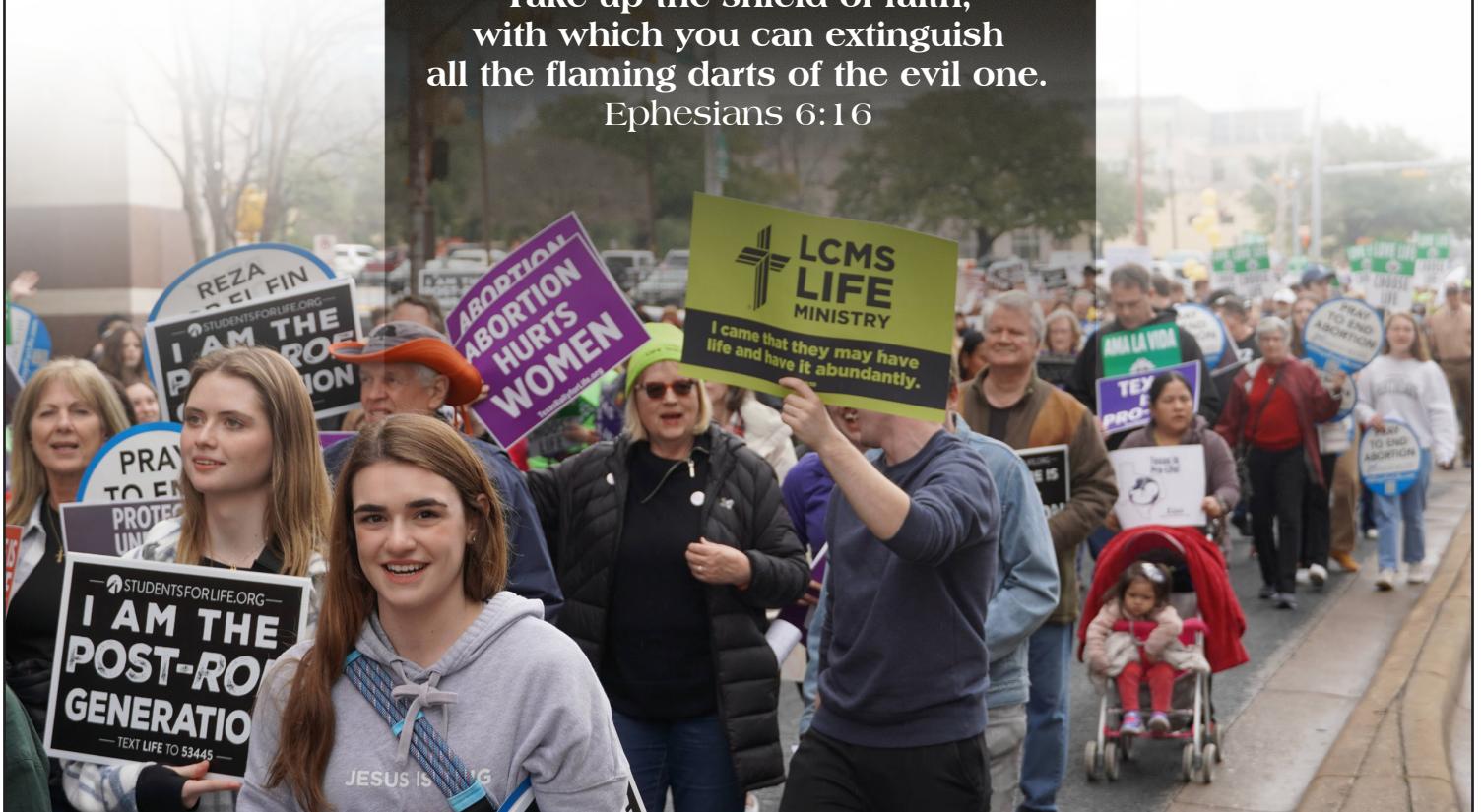
