Thanksgiving

I give thanks to my God always for you because of the grace of God that was given you in Christ Jesus, that in every way you were enriched in him in all speech and all knowledge— even as the testimony about Christ was confirmed among you— so that you are not lacking in any gift, as you wait for the revealing of our Lord Jesus Christ, who will sustain you to the end, guiltless in the day of our Lord Jesus Christ. God is faithful, by whom you were called into the fellowship of his Son, Jesus Christ our Lord. — 1 Corinthians 1:4-9 ESV

Discipleship



The Lord instructs the Apostles to go into all the world and make disciples. The process includes teaching, Baptizing, and living in the Word of God. He says, “Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age” (Matthew 28:19-20). No one applies for the position. The Word of God goes out and calls you. The Holy Spirit drafts you. Luther said in the Small Catechism (Creed, Article III), “The Holy Spirit has called me by the Gospel, enlightened me with his gifts, and sanctified and kept me in the true faith.” The Lord himself claims us as his disciples, showing up at our fishing boat, tax booth, or door and says, “follow me.” Faith comes by hearing the Word of Christ (Romans 10:17). The life of discipleship includes living in that Word of Christ. Faith demands that it be fed by the Means of Grace. Disciples of Christ come to Church, hear the preaching of the Word, and partake of the Sacraments. Disciples read their Bibles and study his Word. They make Luther’s explanation of the Third Commandment, “We should fear and love God so that we do not despise preaching and his Word, but hold it sacred and gladly hear and learn it,” part of their daily work and life. Not only do we hear the Word, but we learn it. The Christian prays. He prays for his own needs, for his thanksgivings, and praises. He prays for his sorrows and the cause of his tears. He prays for his neighbor and his enemies. The Christian is an intercessor. Disciples of Jesus are also people of compassion, charity, and love. We bear one another’s burdens and love one another in our actions and deeds. Saint Paul tells us that the world will know us by our love for one another. The Christian life is a narrow path. At times, it is difficult. However, there is not a time or place that you have to traverse that your God and Savior is not with you. He’s by our side upon the plain and in the dumps and storms of life with his good gifts and Spirit. You are invigorated by the very Word of God that God puts into your hearts and minds. You are made strong by his Spirit’s work. You are forgiven and made new in the preaching of the Word and in the Sacrament of the Altar. God be praised that he has sought you out and bid you, “Follow me!” And lo, this Jesus is with you always.

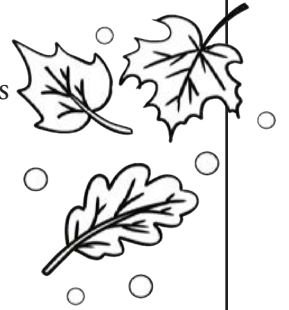

October has been a blessed month filled with events and Eagle sports victories!

We completed our accreditation visit at the beginning of the month. The site visit's report revealed twelve commendations for the school! We are blessed and pleased that the team will recommend our re-accreditation through the Consortium for Classical Lutheran Education (CCLE) in November. This opening statement about Benchmark I clearly states our commitment to teaching and enculturating the Lutheran confessions:

The school is clear on its identity. It is committed to Scriptures as the only infallible rule for faith and life and to the confessions of the Evangelical Lutheran Church as a true exposition of Scripture. The Lutheran ethos is evident throughout the school. Chapel services strive to meet the highest standards of Lutheran worship. With a few exceptions, every member of the faculty is a faithful member of the congregation, and the school leadership is committed to upholding the Lutheran faith in classroom instruction and daily school life. Upper level students appear to be comfortable with their Lutheran identity and can easily engage in conversations that befit a young Lutheran scholar.

As a SmartFamilies (SF) school, we hosted Dr. Collier, who spoke to our PTL about the dangers of early adoption of smartphones among our students. We encourage our families to wait until high school. SF also talked to our K-8 scholars about internet and app safety.

Some highlights for October include:

- We hosted a book fair and a Grandparents/VIP day.
- SmartFamilies presentations for PTL and the scholars.
- We kicked off the 2025 Eagle Fund! Please consider supporting our Eagle Fund!

- Jason's Deli is hosting a Spirit Night every second Sunday.
- Our volleyball team attended the state volleyball tournament in San Antonio, TX.
- We hosted the Grades 3-8 Fall Music Festival.
- Our Logic School visited Jones Hall and attended a Houston Symphony Orchestra concert.
- We celebrated Reformation Day as a school.



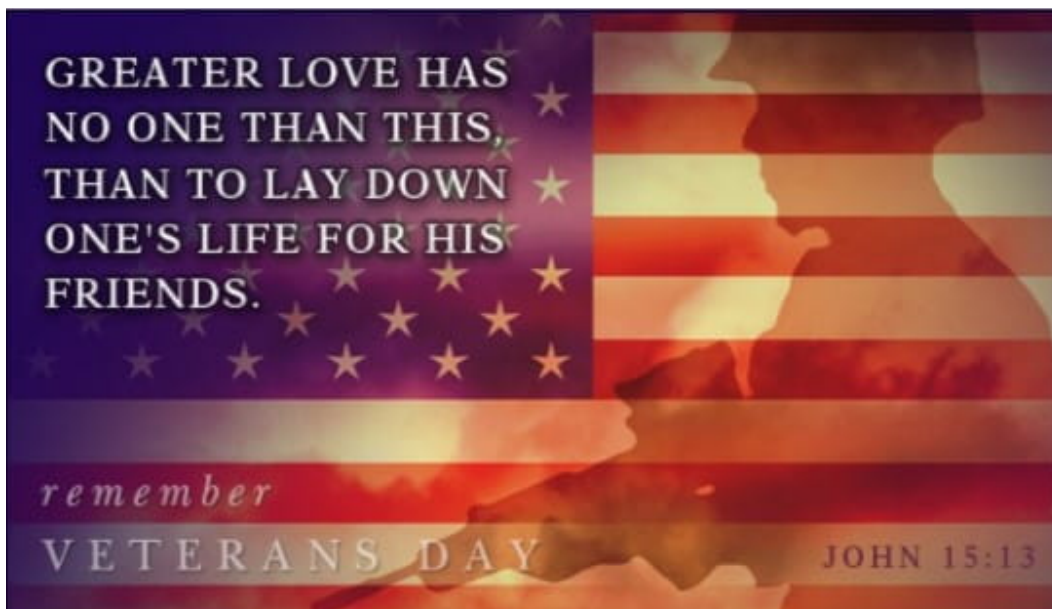

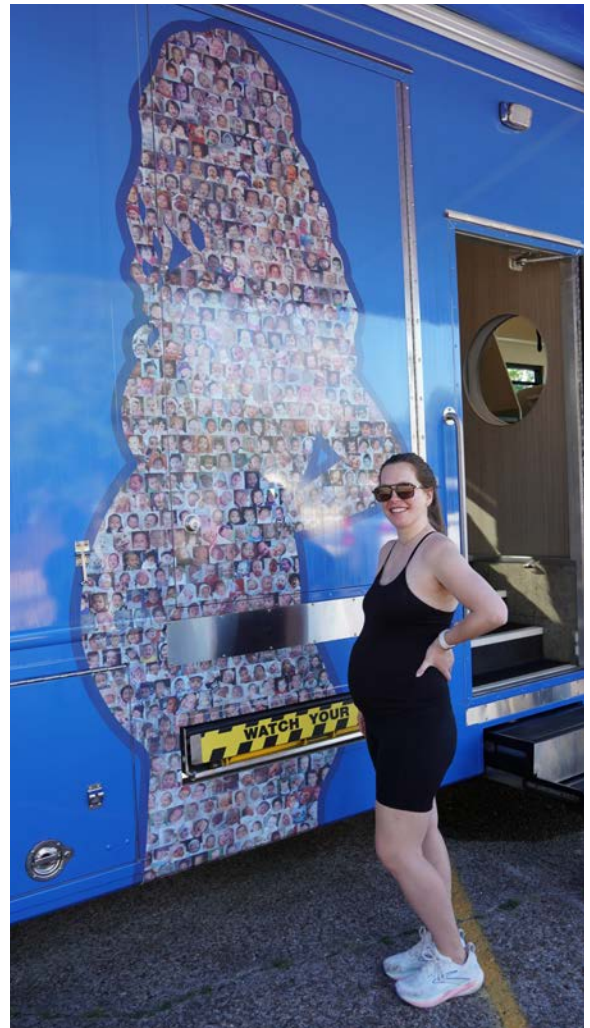

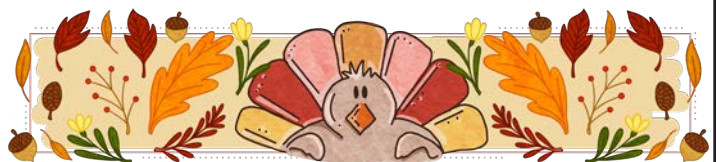
