Directions: Each fish outline below contains an event from this lesson's Bible account. Number each fish so that the events are in the order in which they happened in the Bible account.

○ When all the disciples reached the shore, Jesus cooked breakfast for them.

○ Jesus told the disciples to cast out their net once more. This time, the disciples caught a large haul of fish.

○ Jesus commanded Peter, "Feed My sheep." This meant Peter was to lead the Church.

○ Peter and some of the other disciples went out to do some night fishing. They caught nothing.

○ Peter recognized it was Jesus on the shore because of the many fish they caught. Peter jumped out of the boat and swam to shore.

○ At daybreak, Jesus stood on the shore, but the disciples did not know it was Him.

○ Three times after breakfast, Jesus asked Peter, "Do you love Me?"

○ Jesus asked Peter three times if he loved Him. This matched the three times Peter denied knowing Jesus when Jesus was arrested before His crucifixion.

○ Each time, Peter replied, "Yes, Lord, You know that I love You."
