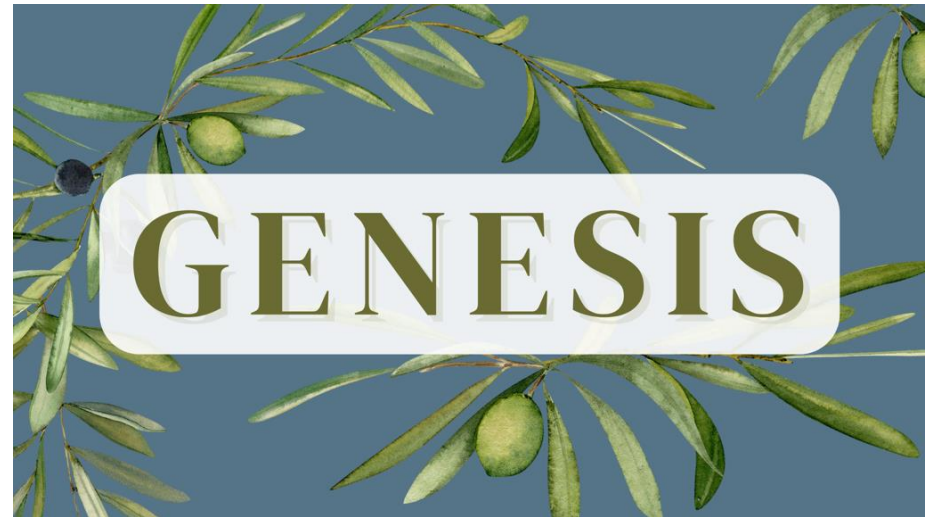


## Final Thoughts

## A Prayer of Faith

- What does the act of the servant praying for a specific sign from God teach us about faith and trusting God in the unknown?
- Have you ever faced a situation where you had to step out into the unknown? How did you trust God in that situation?
- In what areas of your life do you struggle most to trust God with the unknown? How can you grow in that area?
- The servant's prayer was answered even before he finished speaking. How have you seen God move in your life before you even finished asking for help?
- Isaiah 65:24 says, "Before they call, I will answer." What does this verse mean to you in the context of your own prayer life?

## A Potential Answer

- The servant continued to trust God step-by-step, even when things weren't immediately clear. What are some examples from your life where you had to trust God with just the next step?
- The servant sought confirmation and guidance from God and also relied on wise counsel. How important is it to seek godly advice when making decisions about the unknown?
- What are some common distractions or doubts that pull us away from focusing on God's mission for our lives?
- What can we do to stay focused on God's will when faced with difficult or tempting distractions?
