Concept



he ANAT quarterly Prayer and Fasting program will be a period of seeking the presence of God through scripture-fed, spirit-led, and worship-based prayer. This program will take place over three days and will include structured daily prayers consistent with a predetermined prayer and Bible reading plan.

Context



nd while they looked stedfastly toward heaven as he went up, behold, two men stood by them in white apparel; ¹¹ Which also said, Ye men of Galilee, why stand ye gazing up into heaven? this same Jesus, which is taken up from you into heaven, shall so come in like manner as ye have seen him go into heaven.”(Acts 1:10-11)

Since we are following Jesus, He is the only one who can set the standard that identifies His true followers. In Revelation 17:14, He describes His followers as called, chosen, and faithful.

4. To enlighten our understanding of the Word.
5. To be Spirit-filled and Spirit-led — obedient.
6. To grow in faith — taking Jesus at His word and acting with the expectation that He will be faithful.

TO BE LIKE JESUS



1. To be like Je - sus, to be like Je - sus! All I ask to be like Him!

Following Jesus is a call to discipleship. It involves an active, daily choice to align one's life with Jesus' example of love, humility, and service. It is the practice of living a life that embodies the teachings, actions, and character of Jesus Christ. For the original disciples, following Jesus meant a literal call to walk alongside Him, observe Him, and learn from Him. When Jesus' time on earth came to an end, the disciples could not follow Him to where He was going because their assignment to be like Him had not yet been fulfilled—they had unfinished tasks.

Today, Jesus is no longer physically present, but our assignment remains the same as that of the original disciples: we need to be like Jesus. The Word of God and the Holy Spirit serve as our guides. If we are obedient, we will become like Jesus and be where He is. All disciples who obeyed and followed Jesus eventually received their eternal rewards because they were called, chosen, and faithful.

“Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is. ³ And every man that hath this hope in him purifieth himself, even as he is pure.” (1 John 3:2-3)

Failing to follow Jesus will always lead to being lost. Ignoring His instructions will invalidate any assurances. Only Jesus knows how to reach the destination we seek, and He desires to establish a relationship with us to guide us there. We must be diligent in maintaining our relationship with Him by obeying His command: “BE YE HOLY; FOR I AM HOLY.” (1 Peter 1:16) Following Jesus is a positive action; it is the path upward and the way of holiness.
