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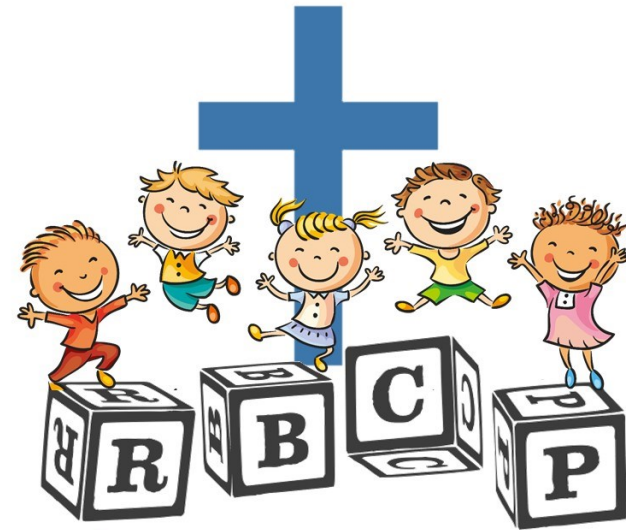

Mission Statement

We are a community dedicated to enriching the lives of children developmentally, morally, and spiritually through academic excellence and a loving Christian environment. Through a variety of fun, educational and Bible-based activities our students will attain the fundamentals of religion and early learning. Faith based education, cognitive, fine and gross motor, language, and social/emotional development are the core elements of our curriculum.

Curriculum

We use the *ABC Jesus Loves Me* curriculum. This curriculum provides our students with both academic and Bible-based learning. Additionally, our staff is dedicated to adjusting our educational approach to better suit the need of each individual child in the classroom.

Arrival & Dismissal



Staff are present each morning at the preschool's entrance to sanitize hands and sign students in before escorting them to class.

Our Facility



Located in the lower level of the church, the preschool occupies its own floor and has its own entrance and parking lot. Both the church and preschool doors remain locked during school hours and have a camera entry system. The preschool includes four classrooms, two gross motor

rooms, an administrative office and two full-sized bathrooms. There is also a small third bathroom located off of the 2s classroom that has a diaper changing station and a child sized toilet and sink perfect for those in training. Additionally, students enjoy our fenced in and mulched playground that includes four swings, two slides, standing musical chimes, a standing chalkboard and an assortment of climbing, peddling and rocking equipment.



Student Enrichment

Students are introduced to basic prayer habits and lessons of the Bible through Bible stories and related activities. Students participate in creative play, arts and crafts, sensory play, field trips to nearby locations and more! Students learn to give back to our community through food drives, Christmas angel trees, and other community events. Students enjoy snack daily at 10:30am and lunch daily at 12:30pm, both brought from home. Through organized and creative play friendships blossom and social skills mature.

Music, library, physical education, and Spanish are offered to students weekly. Music class introduces students to basic music concepts, musical instruments and creative movement. Physical education offers students the opportunity to develop gross motor skills and participate in group games. Spanish class provides students exposure to the language and the opportunity to develop fluency at a young age.

Spiritual Enrichment

Our 3 & 4-year-old classes visit our church's sanctuary on the 1st and 3rd Wednesday of each month to learn about worship from our ministerial staff through songs, stories and creative movement!
