THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

Nearly 2000 years ago, our Savior ascended into heaven, his mission complete. He had been sent by His Father to purchase salvation for all of humanity. However, while His mission was complete, THE mission is not. Jesus left His followers with the charge to carry the good news of the gospel to all the world (ethnos, all people groups). With this charge He promised His presences and His power.

In the book of Acts, we see the church take up this charge. Reading this book is like reading an action adventure. People are laying it all on the line for the gospel's sake. Nothing, not even life itself, is more important to them than fulfilling the mission Christ had given them. The book of Acts closes somewhat abruptly. It seems like it is a book with no end. I think that is by design. There is no end because we carry on the same mission as that early church.

We have heard of powerful moves of God throughout our nation's history. Times where men and women were coming to Christ in tremendous numbers. We have heard how God brought people out of sin, turned their lives around, and set them on a new course. We have heard how God swept through entire cities, changing the very tone and tenor of the environment. Unfortunately, these are but historical stories for most of us. We have not experienced such a move of God for ourselves.

The truth be told, Christianity is losing ground in the United States. While Christianity is exploding in other areas of the world, it is in decline in our land. Why is this? I believe it is because the church has lost its focus. We have forgotten to keep the main thing the main thing. We have relied on methods and strategies more than we have relied on our Lord. We have invested more into our approaches than we have into prayer. The result is that in large part, the church has become an aimless and powerless institution.

We do not have to let this define us. We can make a commitment to keep the Great Commission front and center. We can determine that we will fulfill the mission of the Lord to the glory of the Lord. Once such a decision is made, we simply need to be committed to prayer, humility, and obedience. May we always do all that we do to the glory of our Lord.
