


UPWARD SOCCER REGISTRATION OPEN

THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

As we continue our examination of the book of Hosea, we continue to see marriage set forth as an allegory of our love for God. When in comes to marriage, faithfulness is

acknowledge our shortcomings, confess them, and move forward in a more genuine way with our Lord.

everything. When we stand before our friends and our God and pledge our love to one-another, we are saying I will be true to you and to you alone. This fidelity is the exact theme that God is picking up on in the book of Hosea. He is saying to us, if you pledge your love to me, I expect that you will be faithful.

In our passage today, we will see three familiar ways that Israel was unfaithful to God. Unfortunately, if we are honest, we are often guilty of the same. First, He says that Israel has given herself over to idolatry. Idolatry is when we look to anything else, other than God, to fulfill a need that only He can fulfill. Second, they were guilty of ingratitude. They had failed to acknowledge the good things in their life that God had provided. Finally, they were living as hypocrites. They claimed to be one thing while acting as another.


At a surface level, we might say that we are not guilty of such things. But, if we take a deeper look, we will discover that these same shortcomings sneak into our lives as well. Have you ever looked to someone or something when you should have been looking to God? Have you tried to meet a physical, spiritual, or emotional need outside of your relationship with God? This is idolatry. Have you ever failed to give thanks for all that God does? That is ingratitude. Have you ever acted in a way that does not reflect who you claim to be in Christ? That is hypocrisy. The point is, we all drift. Thus, we are all desperately in need of Grace.

As we look at Hosea's words today, let us look with an open and honest heart. I hope that we can acknowledge our shortcomings, confess them, and move forward in a more genuine way with our Lord.
