REACH AND DISCIPLE

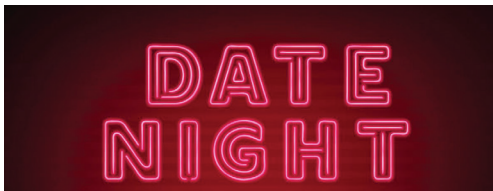

THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

Sometime ago I was at a men’s conference. While at this conference, I met a man who was retired, energetic, and overflowing with joy. At some point in the conversation, I got around to asking him about this overflowing joy. He said to me, “You know, each morning I wake up and just say to the Lord, here I am, reporting for duty, sir.” He went on to say that he simply tried to do whatever he felt the Lord leading him to do. This is the picture of a life lived intentionally.

We wake up each day with an agenda. Maybe we are the type that writes that agenda down, maybe we are not. Maybe we just tend to things as they come. Either way, there is an agenda. The question is, do we factor the Lord into these agendas? Do we have a sense that God might desire to use our comings and our goings? My prayer is that we will all live intentionally for the gospel’s sake.

Today we will examine the life and intentionality of Paul. Here is a man that literally gave up everything to follow the Lord. In fact, Paul said, “I do not account my life of any value nor as precious to myself, if only I may finish my course and the ministry that I received from the Lord Jesus, to testify to the gospel of the grace of God” (Acts 20:24). I wonder what would happen in our lives if we lived with that sort of conviction and that sort of passion.

Today, as we look at the life of Paul, I want to ask you to consider your own life. What sort of things are taking priority in your life? If someone were to examine your life, what would they determine the level of your passion for Christ to be? What are some things that you can do to start living more intentionally for the Lord? And I would ask, what can we, as a church, do to help you in that endeavor.

I know that God has a better life for us than we can ever imagine. But I also know that that life will only be experienced as we join Him on mission. So, let us all give attention to living lives of intention.
