FEBRUARY WOMEN'S NIGHT



THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

God's timing always amazes me. For years I have made a habit of preaching through books. Again and again, I see that God was in the scheduling of a particular verse at a particular time. This weekend, I had the privilege of being a part of a wedding as two young adults pledged their love to one another. Then, we come to this text this morning where Jesus Himself teaches us about marriage.

If anything has come under assault in recent years, it is marriage. It is not just the definition of marriage that has been attacked, but the beauty and permanence of marriage that has suffered. We live in a culture where we put our personal rights and feelings before the rights and feelings of others. On top of that, we are often guilty of manipulating the word of God to justify our actions.

To be clear, my goal is not to make anyone feel guilty or judged. I doubt there is a family in this church that has not been touched by divorce, either personally or by someone nearby. We must always remember that God's grace abounds to us even when we drift from His perfect plan. However, the fact that divorce is common must not distract us from what the word of God teaches us. God's word is clear on marriage, "What therefore God has joined together, let not man separate" (Mark 10:9).

It is my deep prayer that we will be reminded of the beauty and imagery of marriage this morning. I also hope that we can provide some practical insight that will help you to make the most of your marriage. God intends for marriage to be a gift, a blessing, that perfectly reflects Jesus' relationship to the church. However, to fully enjoy this gift, we must be committed to doing marriage God's way. We must view each other as God prescribes. We must treat each other as God intends. And, we must recognize that marriage will not always be easy, but it is always worth fighting for.
