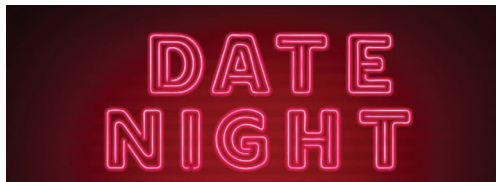
The first practice is the week of March 29. The first game is April 10. The last game is May 15.

THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

If you have been with us through the month of January, you have followed us as we have unpacked our new mission statement. This statement says, “*Northside Baptist Church exists to make disciples that intentionally engage their community for Christ.*” We have made an effort to examine each piece of this statement, hoping that it will have greater impact.

We began with the first phrase, “*Northside Baptist Church exists...*” We determined together that we exist by the sovereign will of God. Nearly seventy years ago, a group of people determined to plant a new church on the north edge of Victoria. They purchased a piece of property at 4100 N. Laurent. From that time, by the grace of God, we have continued in ministry to this day.

Next, we took up the phrase, “*to make disciples...*” This is the direct command of our Lord – the great commission. The great commission appears in all four gospels and the book of Acts. Clearly, Christ intended for this objective to be a part of the church’s DNA. We must make it our ambition to make disciples. However, we are not just looking to make any kind of disciple. We are looking to make disciples that obey the commands of Christ.

The next phrase is the core of this new mission statement; “*who intentionally engage...*” We are called to be Christ’s presence in the world that we live in. As we go about our day, and as we come in contact with those that God puts in our path, we must intentionally engage them for the purposes of Christ. This means we will have to be sensitive to what God is doing around us.

Finally, today we will look at the last phrase, “*for Christ.*” It is incumbent upon every follower of Christ to do all we do for His glory and honor. Colossians 3:23-24 tell us, “*Whatever you do, work heartily, as for the Lord and not for men, knowing that from the Lord you will receive the inheritance as your reward. You are serving the Lord Christ.*”

I hope that this series, “Own the Vision,” has been beneficial to you. I firmly believe that if we lean into what God has called us to, we will experience some very exciting times. We will see people saved, grow in their faith, and engage in ministry. This should be our heartbeat.

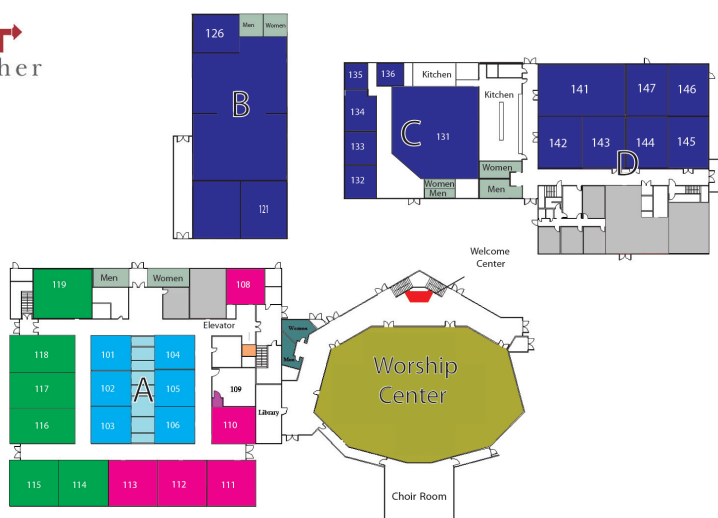
