VALENTINES WIDOWS' BANQUET

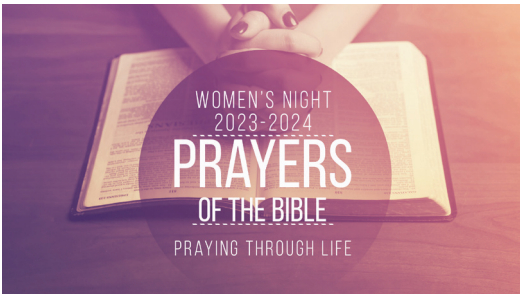

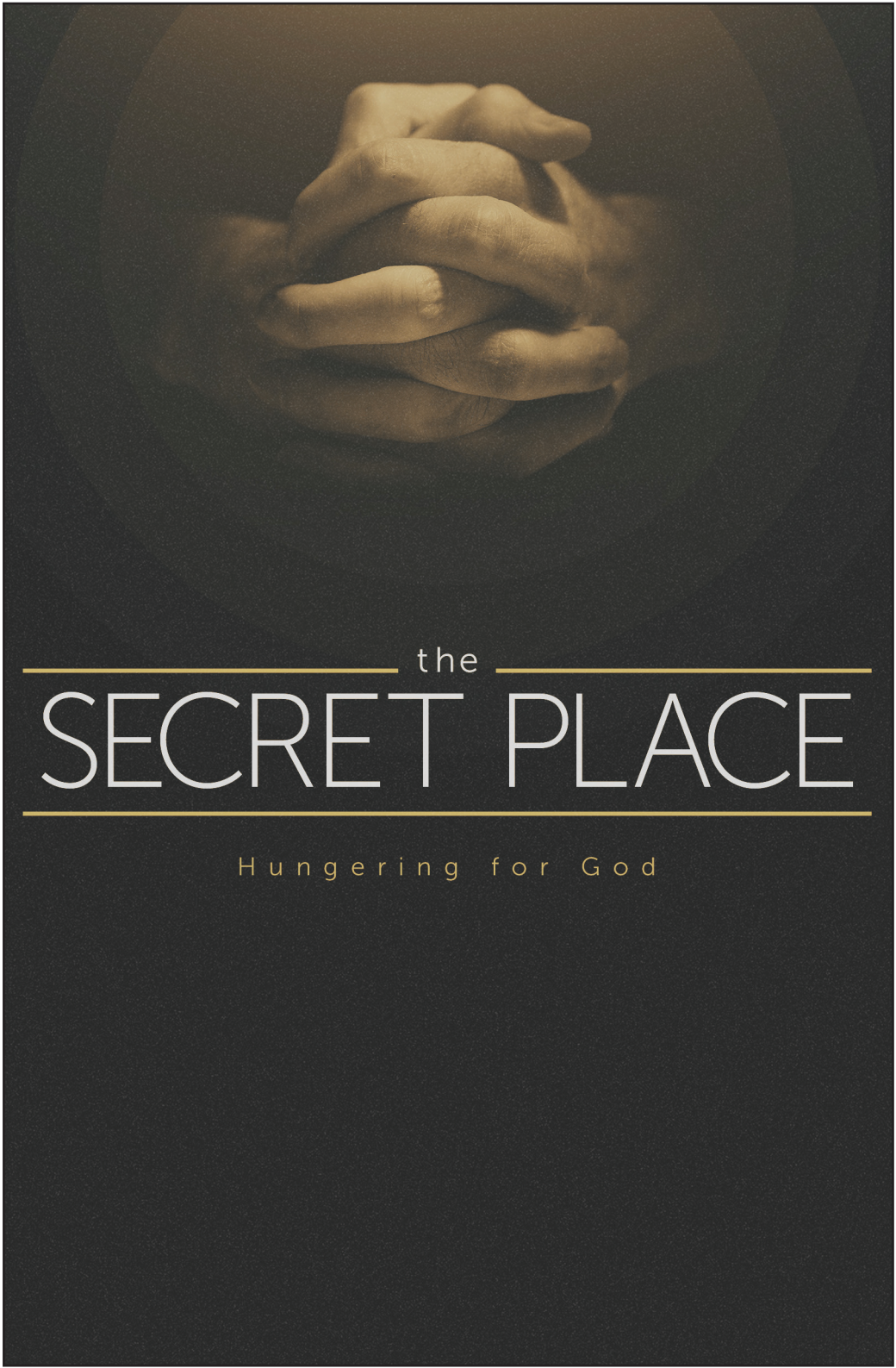


CONNECT

THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

Just about every evening, the same scene plays out in my house. My wife comes home from teaching all day and having not eaten, and my kids come in – one from work and one from school, both starving. We usually have plans for supper, often with something laid out and thawed. However, we do not typically eat until 6:30 or so. Because they are hungry and dinner is still a bit away, they all tend to snack. Then, you guessed it, when supper rolls around, they eat very little because they are not hungry.

Over the last month, I have had the chance to step back. In stepping back, I have been able to do a lot of evaluation. I have looked at how I have spent my time. I have looked at what is driving me. I have looked at my stress levels. I have sort of done this halfway point evaluation of my life and ministry. One of the things that has become clear to me is that when it comes to spiritual hunger, I have been snacking.

I snack on what is urgent and pressing. I snack on what needs to be done today. I snack on the problems that present themselves in my life. Then, when it comes time to really lean into the Lord and be nourished by Him, I’m too tired. Or, you may say, I’m not hungry because I have been snacking all day.

Four areas that I have identified that I have allowed my hunger to wane are a desire to truly know God, a desire to see God move, a desire for soul stirring prayer, and a real desire to see others come to Jesus Christ. It is not that I have not cared about these things, I have. But, unfortunately, the tyranny of the urgent has really stripped away a passion for what is really important.

Maybe I am not alone in these things. Maybe you see similar patterns in your own life. I would challenge you to do an honest evaluation. What importance do these things hold in your life? Does your current behavior and patterns show that you value these things? What adjustments need to be made? I pray that we can journey together to be all that God has called us to be.
