#### **WOMEN'S NIGHT**






#### **BOOK DRIVE**

# THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

Once a year, usually at Spring Break, my wife decides to do a deep cleaning. If this was just a cleaning, that would be fine. However, every closet and every drawer in the

relentlessly pursue you until you surrender to His call.


