THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

In Henry Blackaby’s study, *Experiencing God*, he speaks of a, “crisis of belief.” A crisis of belief occurs when God asks something of you that seems beyond your natural ability or comfort level. It is a moment that will cause you to question whether or not God has the right person. To Blackaby, this crisis of belief is clearly a positive thing, leading us into a deeper relationship with our Lord.

However, I would contend there is another sort of crisis of belief. It is the sort of crisis where we honestly question what God is up to. Maybe it comes when some tragedy occurs. Maybe it comes during some type of a loss. Maybe it comes when Christ is calling us out of our sin and to a deeper level of obedience. These types of crises create a pivotal moment in our faith.

When these sorts of moments arise, we immediately choose a path for processing what we face. We can choose the path of faith or the path of unbelief. The path of faith is one where we ask right questions. God, how are you working in this? God, what are you going to do through this? God, how are you going to bring me through this one? These are questions that bring us closer to the will and working of our God.

However, if we choose the path of unbelief, we will ask poor questions that lead us to the wrong place. These questions are not really questions at all, but accusations. God, why are you doing this to me? God, why is this not happening to someone who is more sinful than me? God, do you even care about me? The reality is, if we do not ask the right questions, we cannot get the right answers.

Today, we will see a group of people who asked the wrong questions and arrived at the wrong conclusion. We want the be the kind of a people that ask the right questions. By asking right questions, we arrive at the right answers. My hope is not that we do not ask, but that we ask the right things the right way.
