

THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

As a child, growing up in a small-town Baptist Church, there are certain things that stand out in my memory. One of those things is the way our church used to pray, asking God to move. Sometimes that was related to someone's salvation, sometimes it was about an upcoming revival, sometimes it was for our nation, and sometimes it was about some issue burdening our community. Whatever the case, I can remember people praying.


As I think about these things, it stirs my heart for the way things used to be (hopefully in a good way, not in a stop changing things sort of a way). I remember our widows — who at the time, I was pretty sure graduated with Moses — faithfully attending prayer meeting. I remember our men, strong men, at the alter praying for their children. I remember cottage prayer meetings as small groups of people would gather and pray for God to move in people's lives as a revival approached. And here is the thing, I remember God answering those prayers.

If you have never been in a small church that has passionately prayed, for years, for someone to be saved, and then see that person walking down the aisle, then you have not lived. To see people weep, rejoice, celebrate, and hug (oh my, the hugs) over a lost sinner who has come home – that is something special.


Why do I mention all of this? Do I think small-town America is better than the city? No. What I do think is that we have become too sophisticated in our faith. When it comes to God moving, we just sort of shrug our shoulders and assume that He will move if He wants to. Instead of pleading with Him, we try to come up with better strategies, better approaches, and better mechanisms. We, inadvertently I hope, exclude God from the equation.

Today, as we look at the text, I hope something will be stirred in us. I hope a genuine desire to see God move is stirred. I hope that a desire to pray for such a movement is stirred. I hope that we will realize that our approaches, while helpful, will never usher in a powerful move of God. So, let us look to Him.
