

VALLEY MISSION TRIP



THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

As we look at Hosea 5 today, we will see that God's desire is that we would seek Him. So that begs the question, exactly how do we seek God? What are some practical steps that we can take that will help us? Well, I would suggest five:

First of all, we must be humble. If we think we know everything or have no room to grow, we are defeated already. To acknowledge that we still have room for improvement puts us in a place where we are ready to learn and ready to hear from the Lord. James 4:10 reminds us, "Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will exalt you." We do not need to lift ourselves up or exalt ourselves, as we humble ourselves, God will do the lifting.


Second, I would spend plenty of time in the word of God. It is in the Bible that we learn the heart and the character of God. The Bible will also show us who we are. Through truly understanding the personality of our God, and our true condition, we will begin to grow. Remember what Hebrews 4:12 teaches us, "For the word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of the soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the thoughts an intentions of the heart."

Third, we must become a person of prayer. As we read the word of God and open ourselves up to what he might be saying to us, we will discover we have plenty to pray about. There are things in our life that need to go, pray for God's strength. There are habits and disciplines that need developed, ask God to help you. There are changes in our lives that we need to make, we will never do those things in our own strength. As we seek the face of God, we must be a people of prayer.

Fourth, be obedient. It is amazing to me how often we will listen to a sermon, read the Bible, or maybe even read books that instruct us in our walk with God, but we never make it to the point of obedience. We hear the truth of the word of God and we find it interesting. We will make note of changes that we need to make. We will experience excitement about what God is asking of us, but somehow never get around to obeying what God has asked. James 1:22 offers us guidance, "But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves."

Finally, seek accountability. In short, the Christian life was never meant to be lived alone. We need people around us who will help us to be all God has called us to be. So, seek accountability and know that we are praying for you as you seek to be all God has called you to be.
