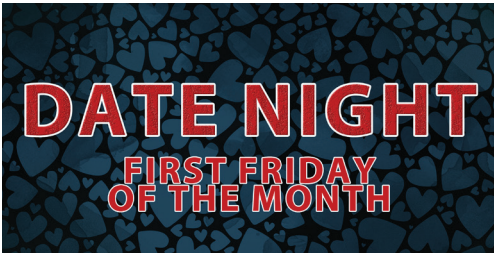

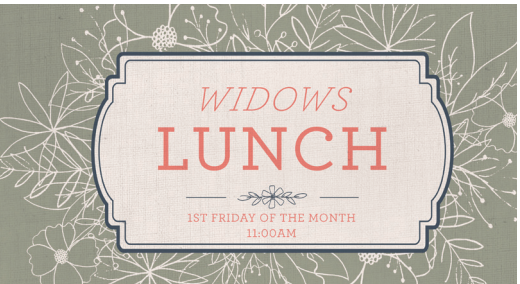
UPWARD SOCCER

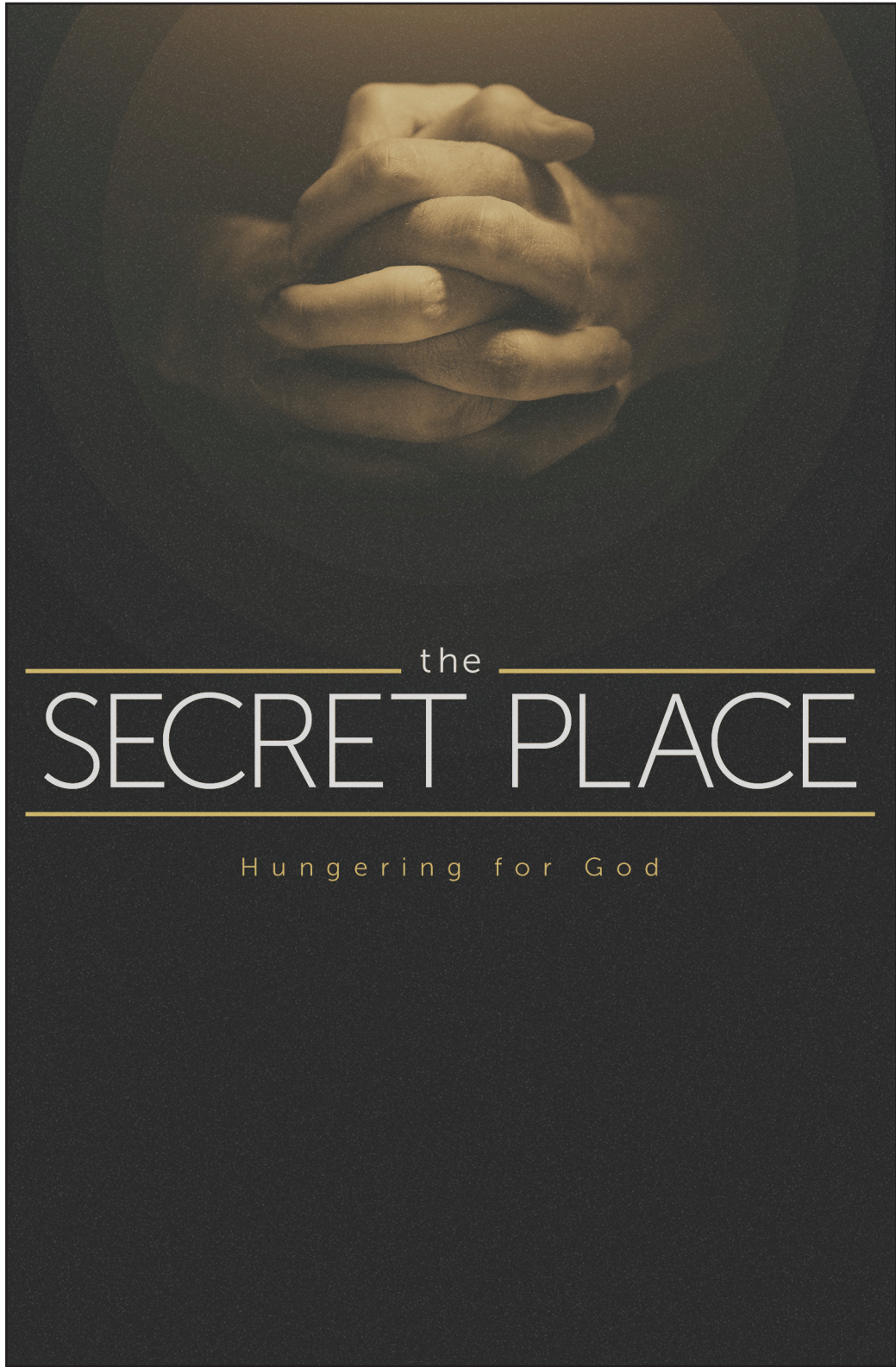


WOMEN OF GRACE LUNCH

THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

Early in my ministry, while serving at First Baptist Church in Louise, I attended a conference on prayer that was led by Richard Owen Roberts. That is not a name that is familiar to most of you, but he is an incredibly godly man that looks a lot like what I would imagine Elijah looked like. While at the conference, he really challenged us as it related to prayer. These were not the sort of empty challenges that we, as preachers, can sometimes be guilty of making. These were challenges to pray from a man who probably spent more time with God than he did with people.

After that conference, I made a real commitment to pray. First Baptist Louise had a long hallway through its education building. On most days, I was the only one at the church. I used to walk up and down that hallway, praying. While I was alone in that church, I was not alone. There were many precious hours spent with the Lord in that old education building.

After several months had passed, one of the ladies commented to Kimberly, the pastor we sent to that conference is not the pastor that we got back. Fast forward some twenty plus years, add a couple of kids, a much larger church, more responsibilities, and a busier life in general – it does not take long before you have left no time for God.

One of the things that God revealed to me during my sabbatical is that I need to make more room for Him. I need to create more margin. You and I both know that I am going to have to create these margins, because they are not going to magically happen. I will have to intentionally plan for such time with God alone.

I cannot help but wonder, am I alone in this? Or, are there a number of us that need to create such time? If you find yourself in the same boat, take time to look at your schedule and see where you might redeem the time. For me, it has been clear that I have spent way too much time on social media. The six weeks I took away from it all really helped me to bring it all into balance. So, whatever stands between you and God, I hope you can make the shift to spend more time with Him.
