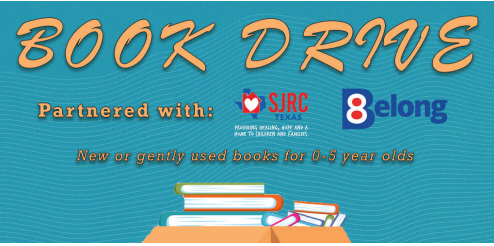

VBS VOLUNTEER TRAINING

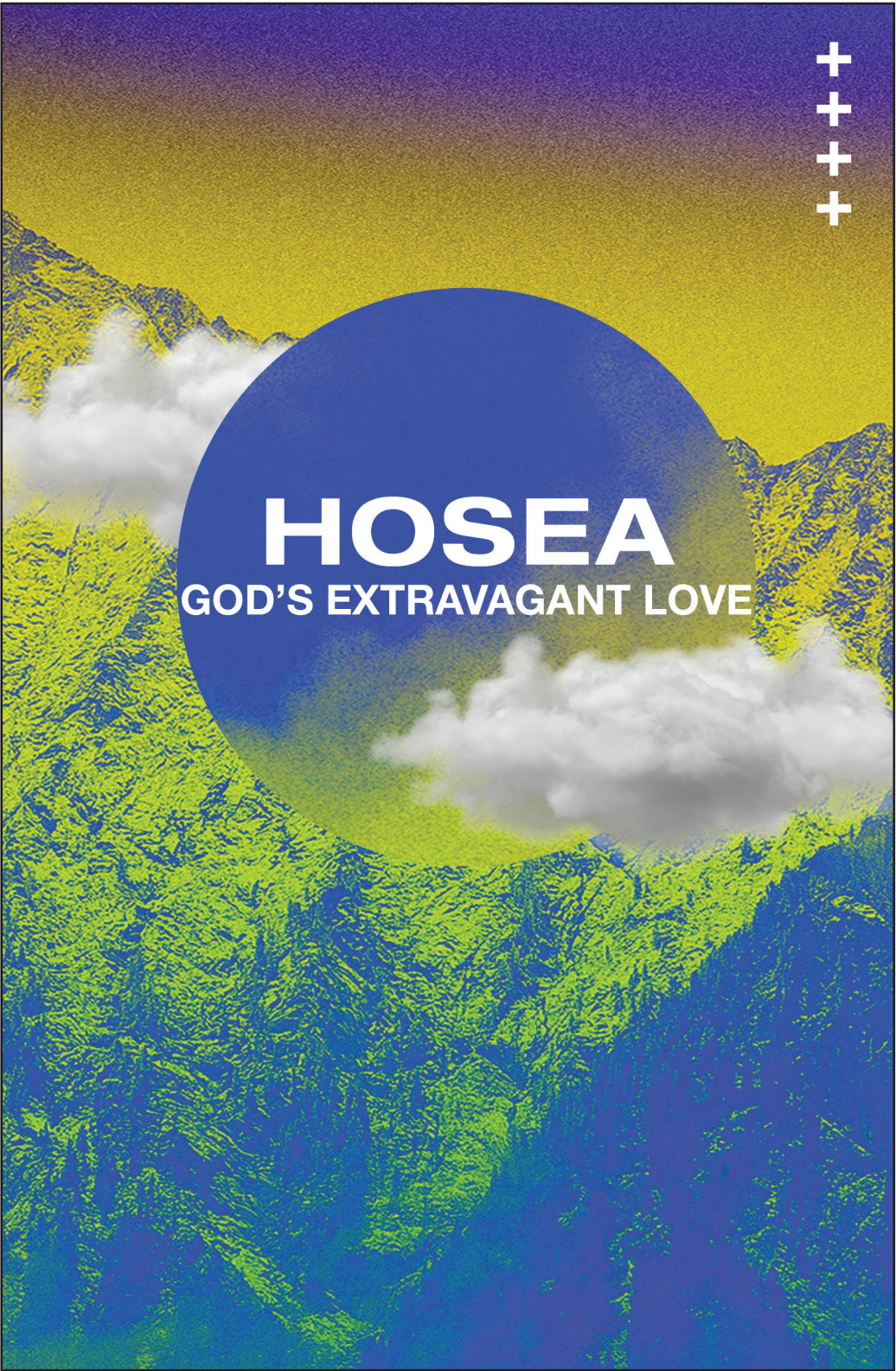
If you want to be a volunteer during VBS, you must attend one of the following trainings on April 16 or May 21 immediately following the worship service. Mark your calendars and more information to come.

THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

In recent days, we have been hearing of some exciting things that God is doing around our country. If you have not heard, it seems that revival has broken out at Asbury University in Wilmore, Kentucky. By all accounts this seems to be a genuine move of God and not some manufactured or manipulated experience. If God is indeed on the move, how do we trim the sails to potentially catch the wind of the spirit? While this is certainly a complex discussion that relies mostly on the sovereignty and will of the Father, there are some things we can do for our part.

First of all, we need to be praying. Prayer is a powerful experience, not so much that it radically shakes God, but that it moves us. Prayer is an indication of humility. Prayer is an indication of dependence. And, prayer is a way that we tangibly express our needs to God. Every great move of God was first preceded by prayer. So, let us be a praying people.

Second, get in the word of God. It amazes me how many people say they want to hear from God but are not reading their Bibles. The Bible is literally God’s word to you. Want to hear the voice of God, then read your Bible. It is in the Bible that we see the heart of God. It is in the pages of scripture that we see the character of God. And, it is in the Bible that you will find the foundational principles of God’s will for you.

Third, repent of any sin that God shows you. When you read the scriptures and pray, God is sure to show you areas of your life that are not in step with Him. When God is faithful to show us these things, we must be faithful to respond. To repent is to change one’s mind. It is to change one’s direction. It is to stop doing what we have been doing and follow Him.

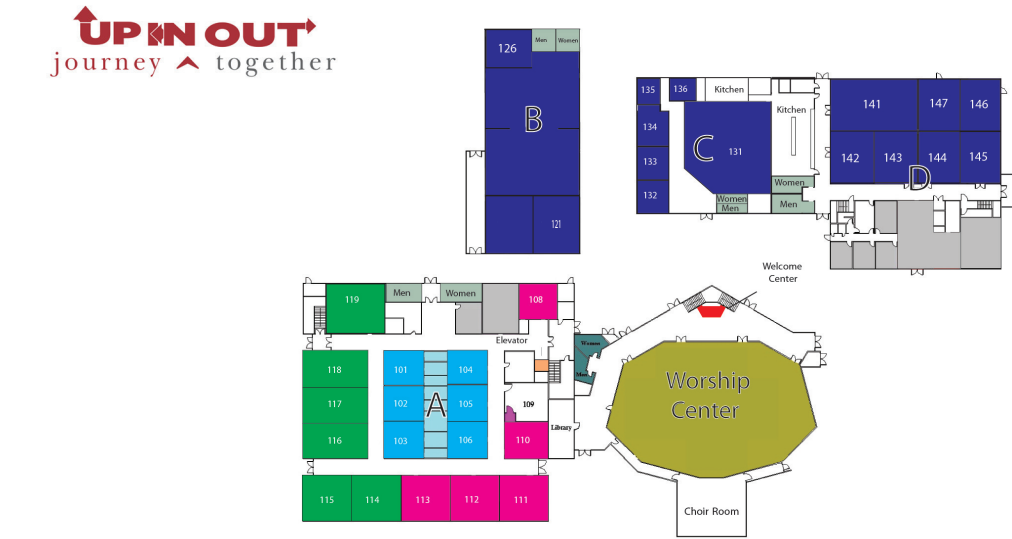
Fourth, have a hunger for a closeness to God. God is not simply some historical figure that we learn facts about. He is a person to be known. We are to walk in relationship with Him. We are to seek an intimacy with Him that is even greater than that which exists between family members or close friends.

Finally, be obedient. When God speaks to your heart, obey. God may ask us to repent of certain sins or take certain steps of faith. When He does, obey. Nothing will quench the Spirit’s work in your life more than disobedience.
