Help is needed at the evaluations. Call Dean Meade at 578-1568 for more information.

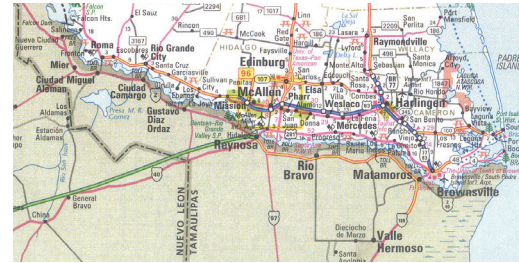
UPWARD EVALUATIONS

THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

From the Covid-19 Pandemic to our most recent “Winter Apocalypse” that we are coming out of, it has indeed been a strange year. Recently, I’ve been reminded that I am spoiled as well as somewhat entitled, not very appreciative as I should be of past accomplishments of those that have made significant contributions to our culture.

Lately, I have been reminded of the significance of humans being created in “the image of God.” Unlike God, who can create something out of nothing, “ex nihilo”, we were created a little different than the rest of creation. Being made in God’s image means that humans have been given the ability to micro-create...and on a smaller plane, we have the ability to take things that are chaotic and turn them into order.

Would you agree, in the midst of our most recent “winter apocalypse” experience, that the inventions of such things as clean running water and the toilet (talk about problem solving) were really significant accomplishments that advanced our culture? Go without it for just a few days and you will come to understand just how significant those accomplishments are.

You and I have been given the ability to problem solve and find ways to improve the culture in which we live. Think about it, long before you and I ever hit the scene, Americans navigated rivers and traveled by horseback to get around. Today, we can travel between 65MPH and sometimes 85MPH in personal vehicles to get from one place to another. Also, there are new prototypes of cars that can drive themselves....incredible. Here is the question that I have been asking myself lately as your Discipleship Pastor: “How do we help every follower of Jesus, work out their faith as an agent of the Kingdom of God in the whole of their life, for the whole of their life?” (God is interested in more than just your Sundays. God is interested in being a part of wherever you are and whatever you do).
