If you want to be a volunteer during VBS, you must attend one of the following trainings on April 16 or May 21 immediately following the worship service. Mark your calendars. More information to come.


VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL

THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY


If you were to ask most people what their deepest desire is, they would probably respond with some form of “to be known and to be loved.” At first, that statement might look a little cliché, but if you really think about it, it is rather profound. The idea that you could truly know me – all my faults, all my short comings, and all my failures – and still love me is rather freeing.

As we look at the book of Hosea today, we will discover that God is really not that far off from us. He says in passage today that He desires steadfast love and to be known. Maybe we are similar in this way because we were created in God’s image. Thus, what He desires is what we desire.

However, there is one difference. We desire to be known and loved in our imperfection and God desires to be known and loved in His perfection. For me, to be known and loved, means you look past my imperfections and short comings. For God, to be known and loved, means you have discovered He has no imperfections or short comings. To love me is to love me in spite of who I am. To love God is to love Him because of who He is.

At first glance, the differences in God and ourselves may look like they would separate us. But the reality is, it ought to draw us closer. The needs in my life are met in Him. The voids in my life are filled by Him. Where I am incomplete, He is complete. Thus, His desire to be known and loved is very different from mine, but that difference is also what meets my need.

There are a lot of things that we talk about as it relates to our Christian life. We talk about disciples and obedience. We talk about the Word of God and serving. However, if you find yourself far from God, simply make knowing and loving Him a priority.


