

### THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

There is a great risk of approaching our faith too casually. We live in a land of abundance. We have all we need and can easily acquire more if we so desire. The blessing of abundance can easily become a curse if we allow it. Instead of leaning into the Lord for comfort and peace, we can turn to the material blessings that are all around us.

Today, we will see Jesus call his disciples to step away from all the comforts of home and follow Him in faith. He sends them out to do Kingdom work but asks them to proceed in faith. They are told to take nothing with them except a staff and the clothes on their back. They will have to depend upon the Lord for food and shelter.

We read stories like this, and we are amazed by the disciples' faith. We forget that it is the same faith that God is calling us to. We must avoid the mentality that says, I will follow God in faith as soon as I work out all the details. It may be that God is calling you to step out and trust Him for the details. We will never be able to know for sure that everything is going to work out. However, we can know for sure that God is going to take care of us.


This morning, as we look at the disciples' steps of faith, I hope we will ask ourselves what God has been calling us to do. What is it that we know God is calling us to, but we have been waiting for all the details to fall in place? What is it we would do if we knew it would all work out?
