
GBA OPEN GOLF FUNDRAISER

THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

Today, we begin our "Journey to the Empty Tomb." Last year, as we approached Christmas, we took a slow walk through the Christmas story. Though our slow walk through the Easter story will not be as long as our walk to Christmas, I do want to spend some time looking at it. For the month of March, we will focus on the Easter Story.


The unfolding of Easter events begins in an upper room where Jesus and His disciples are sharing the Passover Meal together. It moves quickly from that upper room to the Garden of Gethsemane. It is here, in the garden, that we begin to get a real picture of the weight of what is about to take place. It is also in the garden that we see Jesus prepare Himself through prayer.

As we take a closer look at these garden events, I pray that we can learn something about being spiritually prepared in our own lives. At the most intense moment of His earthly life, Jesus seeks to get alone with the Father. It is there that He knows He will find the strength and understanding to keep pressing forward with purpose.

What about us? When things get intense for us, where do we turn? Are we quick to call a friend? Do we seek to medicate in some way? Do we simply seek to escape? Or do we, like Jesus, turn to the Father with a chief desire of fulfilling His will? It is hard to keep a proper perspective, but that is how we honor God with our lives.

Let's make a commitment to always seek God first. Before we phone a friend, or escape into the world of social media, or seek to ignore what is so pressing – pray! Take your burdens and your concerns to the Lord. Seek to discern the will of God and pursue that. I wonder how many opportunities we might discover to truly honor Him.
