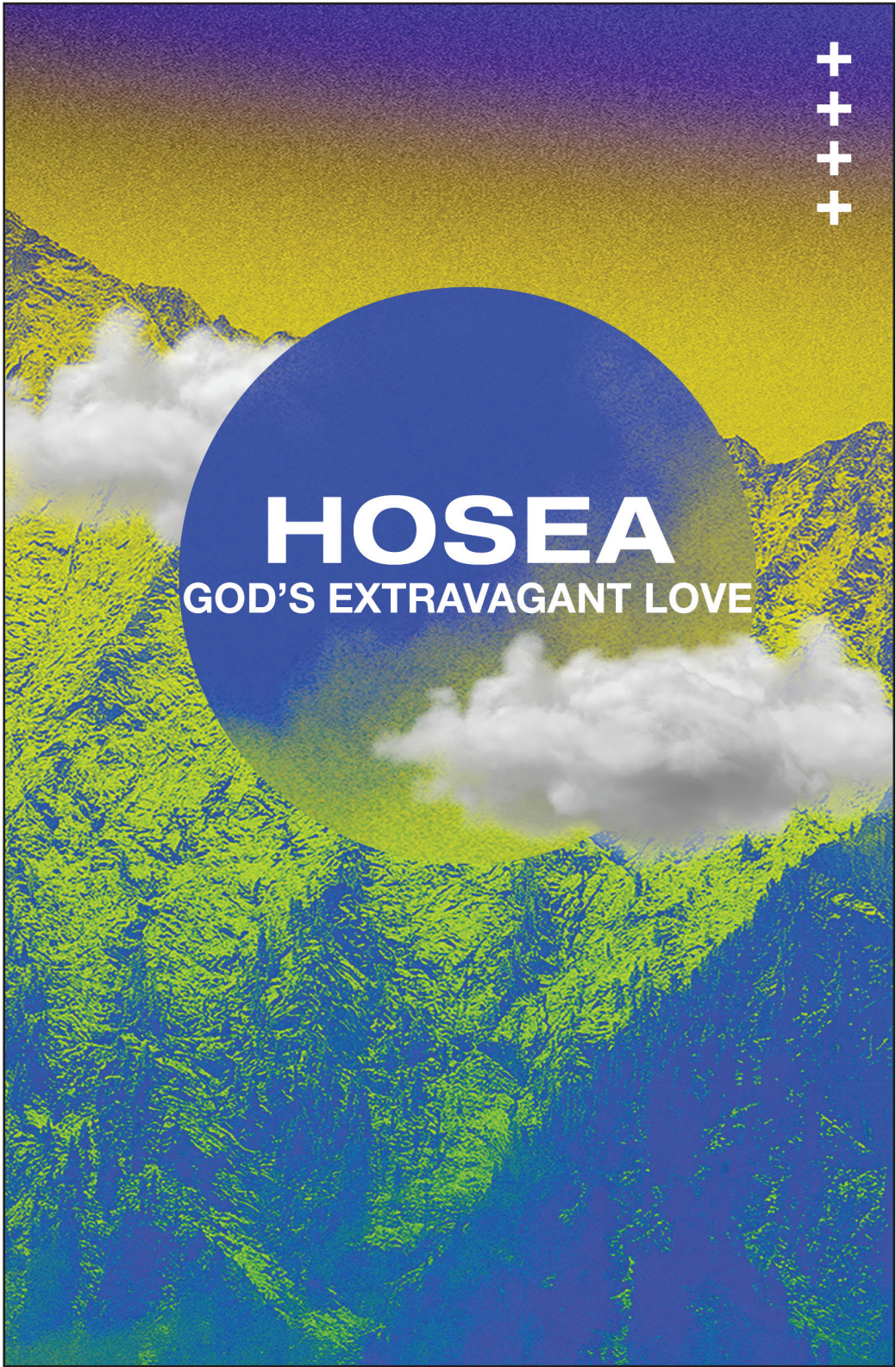

# THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

From time to time you will see a friend or acquaintance that has obviously been to the dermatologist. Their skin will be marked by burn marks and band aids.

“While the results may look terrible in the short term, the cost of doing nothing would be much greater.”

The reason, their doctor has burned away skin cancers before they become a bigger issue. While the results may look terrible in the short term, the cost of doing nothing would be much greater. Skin cancer is something you want to deal with before it is out of control.

These skin cancers serve as the perfect illustration of how we ought to deal with sin. The nature of sin is that it tends to grow. At first, it does not seem like that big of a deal. A second lustful glance here. Drinking a little more than you should have – just to calm the nerves. Justifying an angry outburst because they had it coming. All of these things are spoken against in scripture, but they are socially acceptable so we ignore them.

Because sin is like cancer in its progressive nature, it is not long before it takes over our lives. That lustful glance becomes adultery. That second or third drink becomes alcoholism, or drunkenness as scripture calls it. And, that angry outburst becomes a spirit of anger that burns within us, erupting without any forewarning.

We will see the progressive nature of sin at work in the nation of Israel as we look at today's text. Not only will we see the progressive nature of it, but the terminal nature, as well. Far too often we shrug our shoulders at sin and play it off as a moment of weakness. Sin is to be taken seriously. I hope that we will make a commitment to deal with sin aggressively after exploring today's text. Let us press for spiritual health the same way we press for physical health.

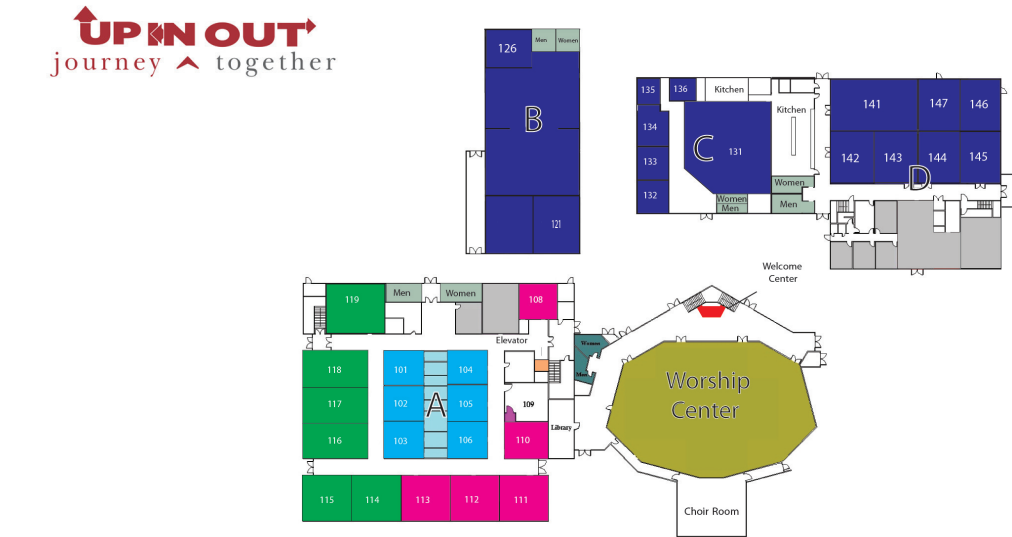


## God's Extravagant Love Sin's High Cost Hosea 7:1-16
