

THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

Sin can have a radical impact on our lives. Not only does sin impact the way we live our lives, but it also impacts us spiritually. Throughout scripture, we see the high cost of sin in others. We see sin cost people their home and security. We see sin destroy families. We see sin lead to deceptiveness. And, we see sin drive a wedge between the God we serve and those who He intends to follow Him.

Today we will look at the impact of sin in Herod's life. Herod had incredible power and influence. These things put him in a place that he could bring about great good or great harm. Unfortunately, Herod did not choose to use his power for good. Instead, Herod allowed selfishness to take over which resulted in great harm.


