QUARTERLY CHURCH CONFERENCE


The next Quarterly Church Conference will be held March 24 at 6:30pm. Join us in the Chapel in Bldg C for information about the finances of the church plus other church business.

THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

For just a moment, put yourself in the garden the night Jesus was arrested. Imagine, you were invited to be amongst the company of the disciples. Consider what that must have been like. Night has fallen. Maybe a light dew has rolled in. The only real light is the light of the moon. There is a certain sense of uncertainty as Jesus has asked you to pray and has slipped off alone to pray Himself.

In the distance you begin to hear voices. You strain your eyes to see through the darkness. The first person you are really able to make out is Judas. Maybe you, like the disciples did not quite understand what Christ was saying in the upper room, so you are relieved to see him. Then, you discover that his intentions are no good and things are about to escalate. Judas leans in and kisses Jesus. At this, the mob that is with him moves in to arrest Jesus.

Jesus is taken away at this point and the disciples scatter. You are sort of left alone in the garden to contemplate all that you just saw. Also, you are wondering what is about to happen from here. Will Jesus be released? Will the disciples come back? Is this the end of the story or is there more to come? Questions run unchecked through your mind.


I cannot imagine what that must have been like. Further, I often wonder what I would have done if I were there. Would I have stood by Christ, or would I have fled? Would I have stood strong, or would fear have taken over? Would I have passed the test or failed?

While we can be fickle and often fold under pressure, the strength of Jesus is unquestionable. Jesus was committed to one thing, and one thing only – fulfilling the will of God. It was His goal to honor His Father and do that which was asked of Him. While we will never perfectly fulfill God's will for our life, we can follow Christ's lead and make that our greatest ambition. I pray that today's sermon will help us to see the incredible resolve of Jesus Christ.
