THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

Authority is an often discussed topic. Such discussions can happen in relation to any number of things. We can ask these questions about church, school, work, or our government. Who has the authority and based on what? Opinions related to authority can vary greatly. However, there is one area in which we cannot afford to get the question of authority wrong. When it comes to your life, you must know who has the authority.

“When we are called to the place of salvation, we are called to come and die to self. We no longer have authority.”

In the flesh, we might say that we have authority over our own life. However, if we look at things biblically, we will realize that we have no authority over our lives. Such authority belongs to Jesus Christ and Him alone. When we are called to the place of salvation, we are called to come and die to self. We no longer have authority.

Unfortunately, this truth is hard to accept and hard to process. Too often, we get things mixed up. We start thinking we have authority over our own lives. We start making choices based on our own agenda versus the Lord’s agenda. When we allow this to happen, things in our life will not go well.

Today, we will see the religious leaders of the day ask Jesus by what authority He does the things He does. The answer, of course, is that Jesus operates by heaven’s (that is, by His Father’s) authority. Jesus was unmoved by what people wanted Him to do or expected Him to do. His one goal was to fulfill the Father’s purpose.

So, by what authority are you living your life? Are you living by your own authority? Are you living by the authority of other people’s expectations? Are you living by the authority of the government? Or, have you made a decisive choice to live your life by the authority and command of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ?

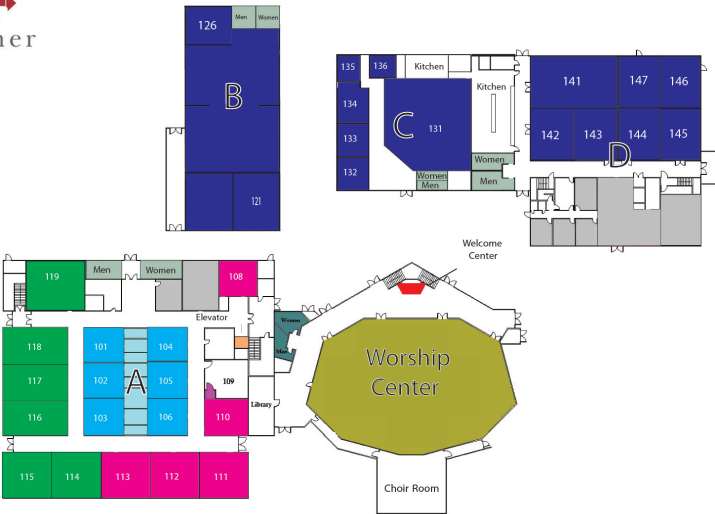
