We have a separate VBS for 5th grade. It is the same date and time, just a little different. Register for "Merge" on our website.



THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

Over the course of a lifetime, we will experience many seasons. We begin our adult lives with relatively little responsibility and a fair amount of free time. As life progresses, we obtain more responsibility and lose our free time. Early in life, there is plenty of time to take care of ourselves, spend time with the Lord, and engage in ministry. Then, we add work, children, and other commitments, and it is more difficult to take care of our emotional and spiritual health.

So, what is the answer? Is there a way to maintain balance? Is there some magic solution to make things easier? The answer: NO! Balance is a myth. Magic solutions are a myth. There is no planner that is going to make your life suddenly manageable. The key is to embrace the chaos. We must make the most of the season we are in by accepting the challenges it presents.

However, there is a way to face each season in a God-honoring way. The key is to keep Christ in the center of it all. There are seasons when we do have free time. In these seasons, we need to spend plenty of time with the Lord and focusing on Him. There are also seasons when we are incredibly busy. During these seasons, we might struggle to find thirty minutes a day to spend with the Lord. In these times, we take the time we can get and look forward to a less hurried time.

I guess the truth is, there is balance in life. However, that balance does not come in twenty-four-hour periods. That balance may come in seven-day periods. That balance may even come in thirty-day periods. The point is this: when you have time with the Lord, take it. When we are rushed, cling to what God has shown you and wait for more.

As we look at the disciples today, we are going to see them walk through a number of seasons in rather rapid succession. I think the lesson we learn from this is to be in the season you are in. Allow God to do in you and through you what He desires to do in this season. Do not waste a bunch of time looking back or looking too far ahead. Allow God to work as He desires, in this season.


